**Description Of Proposed Development :** Yew x 2 - over the boundary and over pedestrians and road. Works: light crown reduction over the road, keeping the privacy on the inside. Whitebeam - outside by the parking spaces for the property. Works: pollard back to previous cuts

**Location:** Westside House Cherington Tetbury Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 11 December 2023 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation. Having considered the criteria stated within Schedule 3 the Local Planning Authority concludes that it will have no significant environmental effects having regard to its nature, size and location and therefore **will not** require the submission of an Environmental Impact Assessment.
