**Proposal: Prior Approval for the construction of a single storey rear extension which will extend beyond the rear wall of the original dwelling by 4.50m, for which the maximum height will be 3.58m and the height at the eaves will be 2.50m.**

I acknowledge receipt of your Prior Notification Application for a larger residential extension in respect of the above which was received as valid on 13 December 2023. I may have changed your description of the proposal to make it more clear, but if you are not satisfied please let me know.

I have until 42 days after the receipt of the application to deal with your application. If Prior Approval is refused you can appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment. You should appeal within 12 weeks of the date of the decision and you must use a form which you can get from the Planning Inspectorate at Chartroom, The Planning Inspectorate, Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6PN. This does not apply if your application has already been referred to the Secretary of State for the Environment.

### **What we do with your information**
