SUMMARY

Three existing openings will be reused and fitted with replacement double glazed conservation style roof lights.

One existing roof light will be blocked-up and recovered with tiles.

Two new openings will be created on the north roof slope, one acting as a replacement for the blocked-up opening [SR-N-NEW-RL1] and one added to improve the natural light in the kitchen [ON-N-NEW-RL2].

An additional roof light will be added to the east slope of the west range [WR-E-NEW-RL4] to provide access to maintain the central valley gutter and a means of escape for the attic/second floor accommodation in the event of an emergency. This egress roof light is not readily visible from ground level.

The proposal results in two additional roof lights in total, with one of these being isolated to the east slope of the west range and not readily visible. The north roof slope only gains a single additional roof light and, as such, does not create a 'cluttered' roof with excessive roof lights.

Roof light: WR-E-NEW-RL4  
New opening fitted with egress conservation roof light serving the attic floor accommodation  
The proposed opening is relocated to east slope as this provides the most practicable place to allow safe access to the valley gutter for routine maintenance or in the case of emergency

Roof light: ON-N-RL1  
Fitting replacement conservation roof light into existing opening - the replacement roof light to be smaller than the existing fitting

Roof light: ON-N-NEW-RL2  
New opening fitted with conservation roof light  
An additional roof light provides improved natural light to the kitchen

Roof light: SR-N-RL1  
Fitting replacement conservation roof light into existing opening that serves first floor bathroom

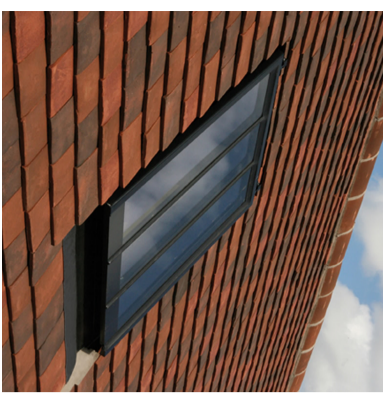
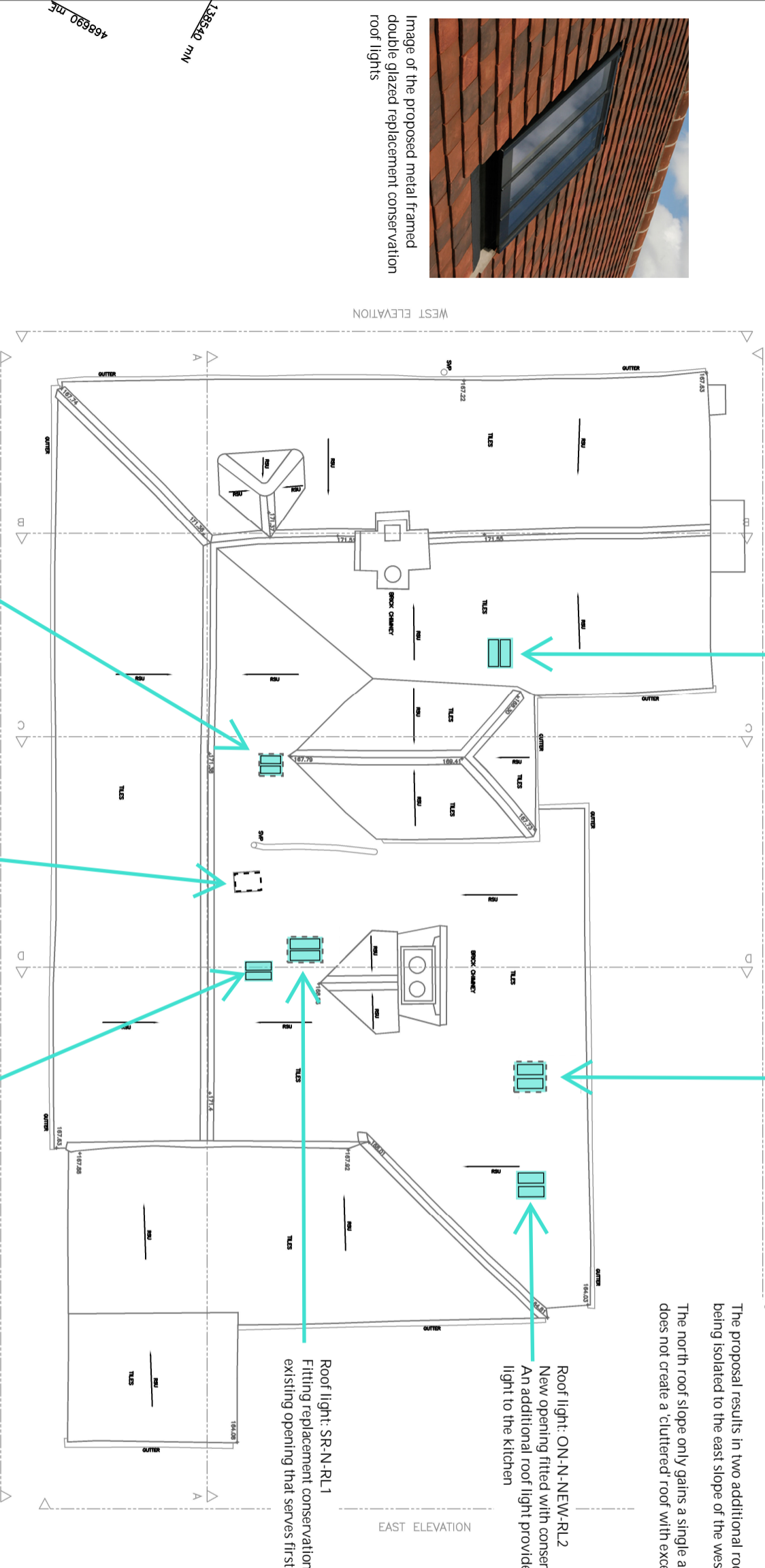


Image of the proposed metal framed double glazed replacement conservation roof lights

It is located behind the chimney stack, which will mean that the visual impact of the roof light is minimised

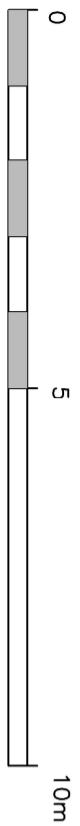
