

Hedge planting mix

Mixed native hedge planting to enhance biodiversity
Planted in random groups of 3 or more of 1 species
in a double staggered row 450mm between the rows.
bare root transplants at 4 plants per linear metre.

To include species of	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Acer campestre	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Corylus avellana	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Carpinus betulus	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Crataegus monogyna	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Rosa canina	60 - 90cm tall bare root
Viburnum opulus	60 - 90cm tall bare root

Ecological Enhancements

Bat Boxes
Integrated bat box, one to each dwelling on south/west elevation
Integrated Eco bat box by www.nhbs.com colour to blend with wall finish, to south/south east elevation of each house
Greenwoods 2 or 3 crevice bat boxes to boundary trees within the woodland www.greenwoodsecohabitats.co.uk

Bird Boxes
1 sparrow terrace to the north elevation of each dwelling
Woodcrete open fronted bird box

Hedgehogs
Close board fencing 15cm x 15cm hedgehog hole to be left in each run of timber panel fence
1 no. Timber hedgehog house per plot to be located within the new native hedge
