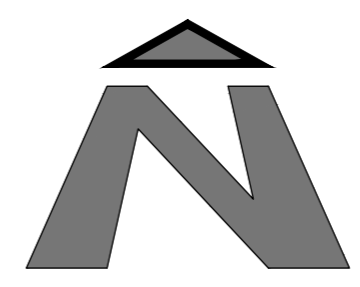

**TREES**

- T1** Silver Birch *Betula pendula*
- T2** Rowan *Sorbus aucuparia*
- T3** Red Flowering Hawthorn *Crataegus laevigata 'Paul's Scarlet'*
- T4** Wild Cherry *Prunus avium*
- T5** Holly *Ilex aquifolium*

**SHRUBS**

- S1** Flowering Currant *Ribes sanguineum* (combined total planted mixture of min.10no. mixed Currants and min. 3no. Wild Roses)
- Black Currant *Ribes nigrum*
- Red Currant *Ribes rubrum*
- Gooseberry *Ribes uva-crispa*
- Wild Rose *Rosa arvensis*

**CLIMBERS**

- C1** Clematis Montana (pink climber) (planted mixture of specimens)
- Clematis Jackmanii (purple climber)

**PLANTING SPECIFICATION**

All trees & shrubs will conform to the specification for nursery stock as set out in BS: 3936 Nursery Stock Parts 1,2,4+10. Sizes as below:-

**Trees**

All Trees within the Site (T1-T5)  
Extra Light specimens 125-150cm high (Stock B)

**Shrubs**

**S1** Container grown 40-60cm high in 3l pots (Stock B)

All container grown trees & shrubs to have at least one full growing season prior to delivery. Avoid signs of being pot-bound or waterlogged.

All deciduous trees & shrubs shall be planted only during the season November - March. Evergreens may be planted September - May.

Note: avoid planting in extremes of temperature or when strong winds are present.

The planting is to be maintained for a continuous period of 3 years. Any trees, shrubs or plants that die, fail to show leaf or are damaged during that period, shall be replaced with like for like specimens, in accordance with the Planning Consent.
