RE: APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO CARRY OUT WORKS TO PROTECTED TREES 60 Second Avenue Frinton On Sea Essex CO13 9LX

I am writing to inform you that the Council has received an application for consent to:

T1 Eucalyptus Tree - reduce overhanging branches back to the boundary line. G1 - Group of Portuguese Laurel, Holly, Pittosporum, Laurel, Griselinia and Lilac - reduce back to boundary line (approx. 1-2m). T2 - Hawthorn Tree - reduce branches by 1.5-2m. S1 - Viburnum - reduce back to boundary line.

The purpose of informing you of their application to prune the trees on your land is to give you the opportunity to comment on the proposed works should you so wish (see reference number above).

Should the Council have no objection to the proposed works the applicant will be advised that whilst the Council may grant approval for the proposed work this does not confer powers on the applicant to enter land that is owned by a third party for the purpose of carrying out the works described in the application.

Any consent issued by the Council does not allow the applicant to go on to land not owned by them, for the purpose of carrying out the proposed works, without the landowner's written consent.
