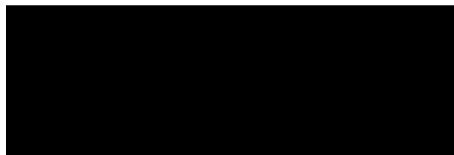

To whom it may concern,

Following discussions with CoCity Developments Ltd in relation to their proposal for the Alba Gate redevelopment: AGS Airports, owner of Aberdeen International Airport, are supportive of their plans to bring much needed Electrical Vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure to the Aberdeen and wider Northeast region of Scotland.

As a major infrastructure hub for the region, we have our own expansion plans for EV fleet and onsite charging, aligned with our ambitions to be net zero (scopes one and two) by mid 2030s. We understand that a key component required for aviation to achieve its net zero ambitions on scope three emissions is for an ecosystem approach to surface access traffic movements. The Alba Gate plans would be a catalyst for public confidence to switch to EVs, removing concerns on energy and infrastructure availability.
