Electricity Act 1989: The Overhead Lines (Exemption) (England and Wales) Regulations 2009 / Planning Act 2008: The Overhead Lines (Exempt Installations) Order 2010 (covering 132kV and above)

It is proposed to undertake the following work that is considered to be exempted from the Electricity Act 1989 / Planning Act 2008 (132,000 volts and above) by falling within the Overhead Lines (Exemption) (England and Wales) Regulations 2009 or for 132kV works, the Overhead Lines (Exempt Installations) Order 2010.

Particulars of proposed works:

Rebuilding of an existing overhead line.

New overhead line to be constructed adjacent to the existing overhead line and will therefore be within 30m of the original line.

The old/redundant line shall then be dismantled and removed.
