About this document

About this edition:

This edition of the document has been updated to reflect changes following a site visit to Locomotion to see ongoing works and verify sign locations.

Please refer to location plans, schedules and bill of quantities for latest signage information for this site.

For example, Main Hall is now separated out into its own zone to distinguish signage on this building from the urban realm.

The Wayfinding Visual and Performance Package introduces the wayfinding sign family for National Railway Museum and Locomotion and provides the detail design intent for each sign product. Location plans shows where these signs are placed at each site, and is supported by a bill of quantities, and signage schedule and culminates in the wayfinding toolkit which gives an overview of signage design assets and principles.

The information provided here offers guidance for construction to ensure the final design is as intended. The sign contractor must review the drawings and details provided here for costing, and once appointed to produce their own fabrication drawings/structural calculations to ensure the final quality, manufacture and installation of signs are as intended by design.

The sign contractor may propose modifications to the design intent and specifications. Where known, these should raised at interview stage for consideration.

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Context

The National Railway Museum and Locomotion aim to inspire the next generation with the past, present and future of the railways.

The *Vision 2025* is on a journey to transform these two museums into inspiring attractions fit for the future, whilst recognising their roles as the cultural heart of their communities —showcasing cutting-edge innovations shaping our world today —alongside the extraordinary birth and growth of the railways —capturing the hearts and minds of the next generation of engineers, innovators and thinkers —and leading the way for regeneration, placemaking and pride in their local regions.

The wayfinding family developed achieves this vision through a coherent and unified scheme that communicates clearly, orients visitors inclusively, and integrates beautifully across these complex historic sites.

Considering the historical context of each site and the transformational masterplan vision, the design scheme created aims to instil local pride celebrating the historical connection of the museum sites to the story of the railways in contemporary ways.

Site analysis

Both museum sites are a true mix of historic and contemporary buildings, working and display engines, and outdoor spaces, and scenic paths. History can not only be found within the collection buildings, but set amongst the sites and along scenic paths, there is something for everyone, and the museums are enjoyed by a vast array of visitor types.

When considering the contribution that these regions have had on the history of the railways, it is clear that local pride in their heritage continues and is enjoyed today.

Unique features from the estates, their industrial heritage and core brand identity are captured in the wayfinding scheme, reflecting the character of museums, their connection to the railways and the Science Museum Group as a whole.























Inspiration

Recognising the unique connection the museum sites have to the story of the railways, and their aim to simultaneously represent this past, present and future.


Taking the notion of a museum that moves you, the wayfinding design takes inspiration from the architecture of railways, celebrating the industrial feat of engineering achieved in the areas and their contribution to the railways globally.

The museum brand colour scheme is paired with industrial materials and construction details and finishes — inspired by the railways and promoting STEM —resulting in a wayfinding scheme that connects the transformed museum sites to its historical setting; capturing the spirit of locomotion on rails in a distinctly contemporary and minimalist way.



















Typology

The wayfinding scheme adopts a 'one-look' approach, to develop across the full typology of sign products required at National Railway Museum and Locomotion.

The following pages show the full range of sign products, splitting them up into the areas they can be found at each museum site, based on the transformation roll-out programme.

RT SHILDON RAIL TRAIL (LAST MILE)

Introduces passers-by as well as visitors to the museum site, providing a connection between the historic landmarks and collections buildings, via a breadcrumb trail route. The last mile is used by pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles, the wayfinding family here identifies the museum, and landmarks, informs about operational hours, provides and overview of areas of interest within proximity.



NEW HALL

Continues the wayfinding language seen outside, with an internal product suite, that also mimics the typology seen at NRM. The wayfinding is minimal, with large overhead signage to point towards facilities or exits when walking between the train exhibit aisles, whilst building signage identifies the site to the surrounding area, and hall name by the entrance at for visitors.

Quality, performance and care

The following pages describe the expectation criteria for each sign type, in terms of its materials, application methods and craftsmanship, to ensure that all signage manufactured and installed are suitable to meet the demands and usage of the museum, its visitors and environment, as well as criteria to ensure products are able to be maintained by staff, rotation of care and lifespan of products.

The information provided offers recommendations for guidance only from Mima Group. The Nominated Sign Contractor will be responsible for the final quality of the manufacture and installation of the Signs.

The Nominated Sign Contractor must review the technical drawings and details provided in this document, and produce their own fabrication drawings to closely resemble the design intention and finish of these designs, and provide final specifications, including any foundation, components, construction and mounting details or diagrams as required. All final construction drawings must be submitted for client approval before manufacture.

The supplier may propose substitutions or modifications to the design intention and specification, with assurances that can be approved by the client. Any substitutions or modifications must be done in consultation with Mima Group ahead of seeking any client approval. Please refer to the *Standards and Workmanship* for more information.

General

About these criteria

These are the 'Performance Criteria' (the 'Specifications') for 'National Railway Museum' and Locomotion Wayfinding' (the 'Signs').

Specifications here must be read in conjunction with the Detailed Design Specifications (the 'Drawings') the Specifications and Drawings together form the Visual and Performance Package which must be adhered to as a strict guide for the purposes of Tender, Manufacture and Installation so that the Sign is as intended.

The Visual and Performance Package should be complied with only in so far as they do not conflict with any statutory or regulatory requirements. In the event of any such conflict, the Sign Contractor must immediately notify the client team. It is the responsibility of the Nominated Sign Contractor to notify the client team of any guidance contained within this document with which they cannot comply. Notification must be made, in writing, at time of Tender submission.

It is the responsibility of the Sign Contractor to use materials, components and construction

methods such that the finished Sign is safe to all parties in any predictable situation for the lifetime of the Sign.

All Signs are to be manufactured and installed suitably for the application for which they are intended using best practice in terms of design, materials, construction and installation.

Any deviation from the Visual and Performance Package will only be considered during the post contract detail development phase of the project (i.e. prior to actual production) and will only be included once approval is granted in writing by the client team.

No additional costs will be considered to meet the requirements stated in the Visual and Performance package, as provided at time of Tender, unless agreed specifically in writing by the client team.

A very high quality of workmanship shall be provided to ensure that the final appearance of the Signs is of a uniform and high quality. All signs are subject to approval of prototypes to set standard of quality prior to manufacture.

Standards and workmanship

Regulations and compliance

In undertaking technical design, manufacture and installation of the Signs, the Nominated Sign Contractor must comply with all current and applicable national, statutory and legislative requirements.

The signs are to be designed, manufactured and installed following national standards and any referred standards therein. This includes compliance with requirements of the following where appropriate:

- · calculating effects of wind pressure on signs
- for all sealants, coatings and varnishes, including UV, weather and rust-proofing

Signs and work on sign installations shall also comply with international legislation. The Nominated Sign Contractor must ensure that all aspects of the technical development and manufacture of the signs (materials, finishes, manufacturing details etc.) are fully compliant with ICC A117.1 and Equalities Act: 2010.

Quality and appearance

A very high quality of workmanship shall be provided to ensure that the final appearance of the Signs is of uniform and high quality.

In principle, various components' sizes, shapes and details are indicated in drawings. If, in connection to strength calculations, insulation requirements, manufacturing processes or otherwise, the Nominated Sign Contractor deviates from the design intention stipulated, then they must ensure that the final appearance is similar to the design intent indicated on drawings and that any modification is to the satisfaction of the client. All final sign dimensions are subject to a complete site survey by the Nominated Sign Contractor.

Allowance for visits to survey should be included and itemised in the Tender. Extreme care and caution must be exercised and shown while working in historical buildings or conservation areas to reduce harmful impact or damage in these areas of significance.

Construction and installation

Extreme caution must be exercised and shown the utmost respect while working in the historical buildings at the site to avoid causing any damage.

All panels and surfaces are to be designed, manufactured and installed to be horizontally and vertically true unless stated otherwise. The tolerance for such a requirement at installation is 1mm over any given length. Ensure correct and accurate alignment of all panels when installed onto the Signs –within the stated permissible tolerances.

All adhered graphics and vinyls must be applied on surfaces clean of grease or dirt, in favourable, non-contaminated rebate, ensuring no air pockets. Cut elements must be applied horizontally or vertically true, respecting any spacing of the original artwork, and ensuring signs are consistent accessible datum.

All joins must be even and consistent with no visible gaps (i.e. no views in to sign interior). No hand gaps or finger traps are to be present in Signs. All edges must be sealed and profiles rounded over to minimise scratches or catching.

Any internal structure or framing must not be visible or have external visual impact. All parts of the Signs must be securely fixed with no movement or rattling and in such a way as to prevent removal by unauthorised persons.

Frameworks where exposed, are to be finished to the same high quality as other parts of the Sign Framework.

Fixings should be hidden unless indicated otherwise and must not interfere visually with the graphics. The Nominated Sign Contractor will be responsible for selecting fixings suitable for their intended purpose and being adequate to comply with the requirements stated in the specifications and match the design intent.

Sealants and varnishes must be applied following manufacturers' instructions. All Sign faces are to be finished to equal high standards.

All materials, coatings, finishes and adhesives must be UV—, thermo—, and dimensionally—stable for the climatic conditions. Elements that may be subject to thermal expansion must have appropriate tolerances applied.

Sustainability

The contractor ensures that care is taken to choose materials, products and application methods that offer the highest environmental standards, where appropriate, including waste materials disposal.

Technical drawings

The Nominated Sign contractor is to supply technical drawings of all Signs for client team approval prior to manufacture commencement.

Prototyping and testing

Before the production roll-out of Signs, it is advised that test samples of printed, painted, anodised and adhesive elements should be submitted to the client for approval.

It may be recommended that fully functioning prototypes be produced of sample products at the actual scale for on-site testing. It is advised that the Nominated Sign Contractor inspect and conduct a ground survey of each location before sign installation.

All Signs are to be installed with a supervisor ensuring guidelines are checked and adhered to. Any problems during installation must be flagged immediately, and the client team notified. Protective coverings should be used over signs until the client approves the installation. Refinements to the prototype may be required if test outcomes fall short of acceptable levels.

Artwork and fabrication

Always use the electronic artwork supplied originally by Mima Group. All Artworks must follow the guidance provided by the client team. It is the Sign Contractor's responsibility to produce production artwork for checking by the client team prior to production. Any Signs containing artwork not explicitly approved by the client team may require replacement at the Nominated Sign Contractor's cost.

Inspection

The client team are to be permitted to review all Signs during production and to inspect for quality of workmanship and quality control.

The Nominated Sign Contractor is to provide photographic images of prototypes during key stages of construction to the client team for partial inspection. The client team may conduct a final Sign quality control review of fully assembled and operational Signs before leaving the factory. This should be conducted well in advance of any installation date to enable any defects to be rectified without impact upon the installation date.

Risks and guarantees

Where required, guarantees for components must apply from when the component is ready to be delivered or during a specified period start date period. The responsibility of developing calculations, shop drawings, manufacturing and implementation, shall remain with the Nominated Sign Contractor.

The Nominated Sign Contractor is responsible for developing all connections. Connections shown on drawings here are only indicative. The weight, quantity, and size of connections shall be determined by the Nominated Sign Contractor for approval by Design Consultant.

Specifications criteria

Materials

Metals

A minimum 10-year lifespan is expected for all metals, based on site-specific conditions defined by the sheet supplier.

All sheets must be of suitable minimum depth for rigidity, able to withstand damage or warps. Sheets may be seamlessly bonded to strengthen. Sheets and panels must have any edges and corners rounded over to reduce sharpness.

Elements subject to climatic thermal expansion must have appropriate tolerances applied.

Aluminium sheets must be powdercoated, colour-matched to the approved specification, and anodised (cost-dependent) when specified for use externally or as building identification.

All stainless steel cut lettering should be cut, powder-coated, and colour matched to the approved specification. Steel dibond must ensure it is constructed with a black foam core and sealed along all edges.

Copper finishes shall be fabricated to a shade approved by the client team, and treated or lacquered to stabilise. Copper surface is to appear slightly textured and matt in finish.

Colours shall be matched to the colours specified in the drawings. Unless specified otherwise, all visible components must be colour-matched to the Sign face.

Consistency and uniformity of colour, finish and coating shall be such that no visible difference can be identified across the range of products on site. Any variation in uniformity that may conflict with this requirement must be determined and demonstrated at Tender stage.

Protective coatings are recommended for all external Signs that can reduce glare, are UV-resistant, non-scratch and anti-graffiti.

Any other suitable or more appropriate method should be suggested in writing with any cost variation, at time of Tender submission.

Any coating used should be applied as per the manufacturers' instructions and, at a minimum, to the relevant national standards. Any coating must be suitable for the substrate it is being applied to and for the intended purpose of the Sign.

A minimum of 10 years guarantee is required for all powdercoated finishes, coatings and sealants, based on site-specific conditions defined by the paint or sealant manufacturer.

Complete copies of the manufacturers' guarantees shall be provided prior to production.

Manufacturers should provide suppliers with data sheets and warranty information to confirm the design life of the finishes.

Damage repair is to be undertaken on-site with prior agreement of the client team. Any repairs shall be to the same standard as the original finish, with no noticeable visual impact and shall carry the same guarantee as the original.

Paint

Paint medium must be suitable for the substrate it is applied on to and to its climatic conditions. Paintwork must have a 10-year min. lifespan, high lightfastness rating and matt or satin finish.

All paintwork must be even and consistent, in colour and finish, with no gaps, blemishes or damage. All paints must precisely match the colour benchmarks given for the appropriate lighting conditions. Paint should be of matt or satin finish and not cellulose-based.

All surfaces must be adequately prepared prior to paint application as instructed. Any protective overlays must be removable without need for tools or solvents, and without leaving marks.

Stencilled lettering must match the artwork supplied to ensure correct spacing. Any cut lettering must be removable without specialist tools or solvents, and without leaving marks.

All lettering must be applied vertically and horizontally straight, respecting spacing.

Plastic (FOREX® or similar)

All plastic finishes should matched in colour, and sheen to the Sign face, and dimensionally-stable to withstand climatic conditions and sealed across all edges and be recyclable.

Veneer laminates (ABET LAMINATI or similar)

A selection of suitable veneer finishes must be provided by the Nominated Sign Contractor, in either black aluminium or dark wood, for final selection and approval from the client team. Laminated veneers are to be durably bonded to furniture substrate using a suitable 3M adhesive VHB tape, respecting spacing set in Artwork.

<u>Vinyl</u>

Vinyl will be 3M 100 series opaque matt finish vinyl as a minimum standard, or similar. Vinyls must have 10-year minimum lifespan. The manufacturer's instructions for application are to be used to ensure longevity. Digital print should be high quality, with samples required.

Wood

All wood materials should be constructed of lightweight Birch Plywood, unless specified differently and be FSC-certified. All woods must be protectively varnished with matt seal.

Finishes

General

All final sign dimensions are subject to a full site survey by the Nominated Sign Contractor. Allowance for surveys must be itemised in Tender.

All materials and finishes must be demonstrated to be of acceptable quality. All finishes shall be stable, fade-resistant, and unaffected by UV light within the design life of the products.

All finishes shall be of uniform texture, colour and finish and be resilient to all known and/or specified environmental and pollution effects. No blisters, scratches, flow lines, streaks, or other visual defects shall be allowed.

All welds in visible locations to be seamless. No visible fixings are allowable unless specified by design or approved by the client team in cases where the Nominated Sign Contractor can prove it is not possible to achieve. All laser cut edges to be finished smooth —no sharp edges.

The Signs should be detailed and manufactured to be inherently vandal-resistant, as far as is practically possible, all common or anticipated methods of vandalism (including scratches). Any Signs or components expected to receive high levels of damage must be designed with a capability for replacement of the Sign or associated.

All visible areas including components, to be free of scratches, distortions, blemishes, dirt, grease and marks upon completion of installation or removal of protective wrapping and packaging (whichever is the later) when viewed from a distance of 1 meter for wall and ground-mounted signs and 4 metres for architectural letters.

Any Signs or Sign components damaged during the process of installation are to be removed and replaced with the prior agreement of the client team. Unless otherwise stated, the Sign faces must be completely flat and rigid in predictable situations. Panels must not deflect or distort under wind loading or physical pressure. All visible flat surfaces are to be of one panel with no breaks or seams unless specified differently or if standard sheet sizes demand otherwise.

Die-/Fret-cut graphic lettering

Standalone lettering is to be cut from sheets and bonded to suitable backing for rigidity and depth, ahead of mounting. Lettering to be powdercoated and colour matched to specifications, and where specified anodised.

Lettering face must show no impression of bonding to backing, and methods for mounting and fixing must appear hidden or concealed through colour-matching finishes. Final lettering must be stable and not deflect or distort under wind loading or physical pressure. The Nominated Sign Contractor is responsible for ensuring the final mounted product can achieve a minimum 10–or 25-year lifespan.

Etched and engraved graphic lettering

Engraved graphics will be created either through acid-etching OR high-resolution waterjet/laser—cutting to be defined alongside the production of technical detailing for bespoke products.

Lettering is to be filled with resin or raised.

Raised graphic lettering

Where applicable, raised character signage must be completed with ICC A117.1 (raised 0.8mm, with a cap height of 16mm minimum per 6 feet reading distance).

It is advised that test samples of printed elements be submitted for client approval before manufacture.

Sealants, coatings and varnishes

Protective coatings, sealants are varnishes are used across the Sign product suite, to prevent or reduce decay, damage or change either via heavy usage, climatic conditions, maintenance or vandalism of the Sign throughout its lifespan.

All materials should have exposed faces sealed, powdercoated or lacquered in matt (or as close to) finish. Gloss and mirrored finishes that can produce glare will not be accepted.

Fabrication and Application

Adhesives

All adhesives should be UV-, thermo-, and dimensionally-stable to climatic conditions. Where adhesive tape is specified, 3M 100 VHB tape is recommended as a minimum standard, cut to fit and concealed. The Nominated Sign Contractor must ensure that all adhesives used are appropriate to substrates being adhered to, and that bonds are resilient to touching, cleaning and climatic conditions.

Adhesion should be consistent edge to edge with no air bubbles or blistering. Application methods to follow manufacturers' instructions.

Unless otherwise specified, self-adhesive vinyl on the glass will be reverse printed with opaque matt finish and applied to reverse face of glazing.

Components

All finishes on sign components shall be durable, of uniform texture, colour and gloss level and resilient to known/specified climatic conditions, and must be demonstrated as acceptable quality.

All surfaces to be designed, manufactured and installed horizontally and vertically true unless stated otherwise. At installation, the tolerance for such requirement to be 1mm in any length.

Framework, where exposed, to be finished to the same high quality as other parts of the Sign.

QUALITY, PERFORMANCE AND CARE SPECIFICATIONS CRITERIA

Wayfinding Visual and Performance Package 2.1 UPDATED TENDER ISSUE

All visible flat surfaces to be of one sheet panel with no breaks or seams unless specified, or standard sheet sizes demand otherwise.

The Nominated Sign Contractor must ensure correct/accurate alignment of all components when installing Signs –within stated permissible tolerances. All joins must be even and consistent with no visible gaps, and no movement or rattling in any parts of the Sign, and must be securely fixed preventing unauthorised tampering.

Where applicable, internal structures/framing must not be visible or have any visual external impact. No light leakage is permissible.

No hand gaps or finger traps to be present in the Signs. Any specified shadow gaps must be of constant and even thickness and depth, as to meet the visual requirements as specified.

Fixings

The Nominated Sign Contractor will be responsible for selecting fixings suitable for the fixing substrate and adequate to comply with the requirements stated in the Specifications, and have adequate protection against any corrosion likely to occur in their position of use is provided for the service life specified.

All fixings to remain secure and shall conform to all statutory requirements regarding strength and type. Adequate measures shall be taken to prevent bi-metallic corrosion between dissimilar metals and to isolate aluminium components from cementitious surfaces.

All fixings shall be of adequate strength for their designed purpose fitted to an appropriate torque, and manufactured from a corrosive resistant material, unless specified otherwise

Any fixings subject to loosening due to vibration/ movement shall be provided with extra security by way of a mechanical locking method (e.g. locknuts) or appropriate engineers adhesives.

All VHB tape to be 3M 100 as minimum standard.

The method of fixing shall not damage anything being fixed or anything receiving fixings other than the fixing/installation points.

Where fixings are visible, these shall be colour and aesthetically pleasing to match/suit and minimise visual impact to the items being fixed.

The top face of all Signs are to be the same high standard of finish as the other Sign faces, with fixings, where required, are preferred to be located on the non-visible under-side or top face.

All fixings used for maintenance and repair access must be hex-socket heads (at a size to be agreed) unless mechanical requirements dictate otherwise (in which case approval must be obtained) and unless easily accessible (in which case security fixings must be used).

Removable items that require access or removal shall use fixings retained into the sign or panel. These fixings should not be of a self-tapping type, but should use appropriate threaded inserts, tapped metal or removable threaded parts such as nuts.

Rivets and any other non-removable fixings are not acceptable where removal or replacement of that associated Sign component is likely.

Modelmaking/3D printing

Extruded elements must be constructed of durable material suitable to heavy use and climatic conditions. Any bonds must be seamless and hidden and durable. Extruded elements may be 3D printed or mould-made (cost dependent), with prototype sample produced ahead of manufacture for approval by the client team.

The Nominated Sign Contractor should ensure all elements are UV-stable, thermo-stable and dimensionally stable for the climatic conditions, prepared and built externally prior to installation, and able to achieve a 10-year minimum lifecycle.

Mounting

The Nominated Sign Contractor is responsible for developing appropriate mounting details and any bespoke fixings across the site.

Any connection bars or frames, particularly for lettering must be stable, resilient and discrete.

Appropriate calculations will be undertaken before construction to ensure all roof/wall/ ceiling/ gate/post/floor mounted Signs fixings and foundations are sufficient for environmental conditions such as wind loading.

Where possible, mounting/fixing must match the Specifications intent provided. Should the Nominated Sign Contractor advise differently this would require prior written confirmation.

Printed and painted graphics and lettering

All paintwork and print are to be even and consistent, with no holes, blemishes or damage, and applied horizontally and vertically straight and true, at consistent datums.

Where Signs are accessible, protective finishes are recommended against vandalism.

Print and painted applications must be suitable for surfaces and substrates, and UV-, thermo– and dimensionally-stable in climatic conditions, across the specified lifespan of the Sign.

All colours must precisely matched to colour benchmarks given for the appropriate lighting conditions. The paint and print colour should match consistently. Glossy finishes should be avoided, with matt finishes and laminates advised.

All printed inks must be solid, without streaks of marks, opaque and UV-stable and suitable for substrates when printing direct to media.

All surfaces to be prepared before application as per manufacturer's guidelines. Any protective films or tapes used must be low-tack and possible to remove without tools, solvents or cleaning solutions, and without leaving any marks on visible surfaces.

All printed applications require a minimum 5–10-year lifespan dependant on where it is used, and based on site-specific conditions as defined by the paint/ink supplier.

Structural engineering and foundations

The structural design of any steelwork and foundations shown here are indicative. The Nominated Sign Contractor must review the design and carry out structural checks and certification of the final design to comply with local legislation, and can suggest alternative foundation types.

Site surveys must be carried out to ensure the final foundation design does not impact underground services.

Care must be taken by the installer to ensure a neat junction between the finished floor materials and the sign structure.

Structural framework

Galvanised low-carbon steel, aluminium or stainless steel internal frames are acceptable for external Signs, as long as the structural integrity and aesthetic intent are guaranteed. It is the responsibility of the Nominated Sign Contractor to review the design intent, and carry out structural engineering calculations for approval –clarifying the tolerances given by the selected materials and fixings.

Interior Signs that require wood or similar internal structural frameworks, must be encased in powdercoated metal, so that no wood is visible.

All materials, coatings, finishes and adhesives should be UV-stable and dimensionally stable for climatic conditions. Elements that may be subject to thermal expansion must have appropriate tolerances applied.

The manufacturer must ensure that coatings are applied in line with suppliers' best practice guidance and that specific care is taken to minimise any damage to the coating. Any damage to the coating must be minimised and touched-up. This includes exposure of the mild steel caused by on-site cutting, drilling or other abrasion and the use of fixings that penetrate the coating.

All steel must be sandblasted, and outer corners demurred. Base plates must be hidden unless otherwise stated. All visible hardware must be powdercoated and colour-matched to the detail specifications unless specified otherwise.

Welds and joinery

All visible welds must be continuous and cut flat; no intermittent chain welds are permitted. All holes for the galvanising process should be marked on a construction drawing.

All visible parts, plates, and sections must be precision cut (no 'shear cutting').

Maintenance and care

Caring for metals and plastics

Metal surfaces should be handled wearing cotton microfibre gloves (or similar) to avoid fingerprints or smudges.

Dry cleaning must be avoided when cleaning signage to prevent surface scratches or damage. Mechanically blow all surfaces to remove loose debris before cleaning.

A mild solution of washing up liquid (or equivalent cleaning agent) with lukewarm water is advised to avoid scratches and/or corrosion of surfaces, finishes and bonding.

Following cleaning, surfaces should be manually polished off using a lint-free cloth (or similar).

Caring for vinyls and veneers

When cleaning vinyl graphics are applied on to glazing cleaner designed for high-quality painted surfaces. The cleaner must be wet, non-abrasive, without solid solvents and have a pH value between 3 and 11 (neither strongly acidic nor strongly alkaline). Rinse thoroughly after cleaning and dry with a soft cloth or rubber squeegee to avoid water spots.

Note: cleaning a vinyl or veneer applied on to solid substrates internally should be gently wiped with a soft, lint-free dry cloth to remove any dust.

Access

All Sign components should be accessible for ongoing maintenance, or changing of graphical components. The design of the Signs must allow easy access for maintenance of all external and internal components.

Panels and components must be easily replaceable in the event of damage.

So far as is practically possible, maintenance access shall be made possible without involving the disproportionate dismantling of parts or making adjacent areas unavailable.

Access for maintenance and repair should only be with use of appropriate professional tools. There should be minimal visible interference from such access features. All fixings must be hidden or tamper-proof to prevent vandalism.

The Nominated Sign Contractor is to consult the client team for approval of the proposed methods of access prior to manufacture.

Maintenance schedule

A monthly visual inspection is recommended to check for surface scratches, sign-face damage, graffiti, structural damage and non-standard signing due to operational updates etc.

Checking and removing dust building with a vacuum cleaner or similar monthly sign cleaning is recommended, as well as quarterly: of exterior surfaces and supporting structures.

Replacement parts (hardware, mechanical fasteners) are recommended to be kept in stock for quick maintenance or repair should the need arise. A disposal procedure is recommended to determine which obsolete elements can be removed, reused or discarded and how.

Wayfinding guidelines and toolkit

The following chapter provide an overview of wayfinding essentials, graphic assets and layout principles which form the basis of the wayfinding design for the National Railway Museum and Locomotion. For more information on specific wayfinding product types including the character limits, please refer to *Specifications Intent*.


Wayfinding adopts design assets from the Science Museum Group brand toolkit, and adapting assets only where necessary to ensure that wayfinding is coherent with the brand, yet effective and accessible as signage products across the museum sites.

The result is a wayfinding scheme that shares design values of the Science Museum Group, and that is easy and effective for visitors to become familiar with and follow as they explore the museum.

Essentials: wayfinding basics

The act of wayfinding doesn't take place in isolation. The surrounding environment and services are all part of the experience of navigating a space. Before focusing on the elements of wayfinding, it is necessary to highlight the essentials when planning a space to meet visitors' basic needs.

If done well, meeting visitors' basic needs should appear invisible and create solid ground for delivering those little extras which can elevate their experience.



Essentials: wayfinding best practices

Wayfinding can improve how visitors interact with and engage with the character of a place, by quickly and effectively aiding decision-making through identification, orientation and direction, and encouraging exploration.

The best wayfinding practices:

Create recognition and identification

If its easy to spot in its environment, its easy to follow, attracting attention from afar

Use consistency and predictability

Standardising how and where information is placed and set —building confidence in visitors to find what they need and act upon it more easily

Provide answers at the right time

Through progressive disclosure, just the right amount of information is given, just when it is needed to aid decision making.

Establish information hierarchy

Simplifying and grouping information into learnable chunks according to importance, and separating different types of content improves cognition

Reduce visual noise

Too much information is unhelpful. Reducing visual clutter improves prominence and clarity

Adopt logical naming

Consistent, unique and simple naming structures, are easier to remember, understand and navigate. Calling the same thing by different names, or using the same words for different places may cause confusion.

Encourage exploration

Creating a visual map of the area/site aids orientation and encourages exploration

Create inclusivity and belonging

Different people have different needs, different knowledge of an area and different journey times, different abilities. By responding to these needs wayfinding is considerate of everybody.



Essentials : naming best practices

Naming conventions are a key element to wayfinding, and should be consistent at every touchpoint that forms part of the visitor journey to avoid confusion.

Pre-visit: online, emails, and marketing
On site: on signs, buildings, maps, marketing
Word of mouth: staff and locals should give
be able to give directions using the same names
and descriptions.

Considerations should also ensure that names are:

Short: and simple to read, legible on the go (2-3 words)

Logical: to understand and consistent across all sites

Unique: and memorable to recognise (avoids duplication)

Easy: to say and spell by everyone


Inclusive: of all to be welcoming and usable

Relate-able: to the area and describable

When naming is long, difficult to remember, confusing, they are likely to be renamed or shortened by staff to make it easier to give directions, create meeting points or remember —which may confuse visitors.

Design that connects us



Palette: colour and materiality


The palette for wayfinding is derived from the brand, architecture and engineering –with colours, materiality, and construction inspired by the estate and railways -the wayfinding palette is bold, contemporary and connected to the museum, its surroundings and railway engineering.

The monochromatic colour scheme offers is not only bold but accessible also –offering a tonal contrast that far exceeds the minimum 70% tonal contrast required for legibility. Colour accents also help to punctuate products from the environment and/or emphasis icons when necessary.

Finishes are deliberately matt or low sheen to avoid glare against content.

Where fixing methods are exposed, these should be colour matched to product fascias and tamper-proof.

For sign specific colour or materiality, please refer to the wayfinding schedule or Specifications Intent.


Assets: directional (arrows + proximity)

Wayfinding adopts design assets from the Science Museum Group brand toolkit, and enhance aspects to meet the specific requirements of the museum sites.

Arrows indicate the direction of travel or a level change for a given destination, and are shown as twice the x-height of text.

Proximity indicated the distance to reach a destination in metres, and are shown at half the x-height of text. Proximity is useful to inform visitors of the distance to reach key facilities and/or attractions.

Both arrows and proximity are shown in the same colour as text on signage.



Sitewide maps are typically found external in square format on totems and waits, and provide an overview of the museum with the site perimeter.

Maps use icons to identify where you are the site, the museum building, access, attractions and facilities, and may marked city transport hubs or landmarks beyond.

A legend and QR code enable further information to be found.

Typically monochromatic in tones of black and white, an accent colour is also available to emphasise location.



Typically monochromatic in tones of black and white, an accent colour is also available to emphasise location.

Assets: pictogram audit (required for signage)

Using the sign schedule, a list of pictograms has been identified that would be required for wayfinding.

It is the responsibility of the client to provide all pictograms identified here ahead of artwork production. Any pictograms outstanding from pictogram library must be designed by the SMG Design Team.



Principles: placement

Consistency of sign placement enables visitors to always know where to look for information they need.

A fix suite of vertical datum has been set for wayfinding, for clarity and consistent to ensure visibility and accessibility.

- 0-0.6m : clear of printed wayfinding cannot fall within this range
- 0.65–1.6m: ideal for raised and/or tactile elements
- 1.1–1.8m: optimal range for detailed content such as maps or small directions
- 1.5–3.2m : optimal range for vehicular signage (with car park signage above 1.5m)
- 2.1–2.4m: ideal for projecting and overhead signs
- 2.4–3.2m : fixed height above floor level for fingerpost and entrance/threshold signs



Note: datums shown are based on ergonomic and accessible best practices, some deviations may occur based on environmental constraints

Principles: categorising

Establishing a hierarchy for information on signage allows visitors to more easily find the information they seek.

- LOCATION: Where am 1?
 Typically an area name identifier, found on the side, post or top of signs.
- DIRECTION: Which way and how far?
 Typically arrow led, pointing to the museum, attractions, key facilities or exits (with proximity on pedestrian signage)
- ORIENTATION: What is around?
 Typically a map providing locational information and placed beneath directions on signage
- SUPPLEMENTARY: Anything else to note?

 Typically legends, statutory or access to online information, placed at the bottom of signage

Note: whilst these principles are based on best practices, some deviations may occur product to product based on content requirements or signage constraints.

Principles: grouping

In any category, information is organised consistently; either by direction, destination type or proximity.

• DIRECTIONAL INFORMATION:

Information is arrow led and organised in counter-clockwise order, with destinations listed based on their proximity from the sign and followed by a pictogram or proximity indicator if appropriate.

ORIENTATION INFORMATION:

Information is oriented north, with current location centred in view or emphasised by colour. Numbers indicate attractions, icons indicate facilities or access, and a pinpoint identifies your location on the plan. Legends list numbered items and icons displayed, in numeric and then alphabetical order.

STATUTORY INFORMATION :

Information organised in order of category –mandatory (*must do*), prohibitive (*don't do*) and cautions (*beware/note*), and ideally paired with a pictogram which sits above text.

• DIVIDER LINES:

Where multiple information categories exist on a sign, these are grouped as above, and separated by a horizontal divider line.

Note: whilst these principles are based on best practices, some deviations may occur product to product based on content requirements or signage constraints.




Divider lines break up groups of information

Principles: directional hierarchy

Content is organised by direction in counter-clockwise order left to right, destinations listed beneath arrows.

- Where multiple destinations exist in any given direction, these are organised in order of their proximity from the sign alphanumerically.
- Dedicated margins and spacing enables directional information to be displayed and listed clearly, with content being listed and aligned based on direction (either left or right).
- The scale of arrows, text, pictograms and proximity is determined by the x-height of the sign type. With arrows sitting above text, and text being followed by pictograms and then proximity.


Principles: destination hierarchy

Where listed, destinations are ordered based on proximity to the sign or in order of category.

- Where multiple destinations exist in any given direction, these are organised in order of destination status, followed by their proximity from the sign. Where destinations are equal in status and proximity, these are listed alphabetically.
- Where multiple destinations exist in a legend, these are organised numerically, as shown on plan, or alphabetically if an icon, organised by category: access (entrances, lifts, ramps, stairs), facilities (cafe, lockers, shop, toilets), services (information point, parking, tickets), beyond the museum (city landmarks, station hub)



Principles: layout spacing

Content is formatted in consistent layouts across sign types, with divider lines, consistent alignment, clear margins and proportional spacing.

- Dedicated margins create clear spacing between content and fixing methods, as well as establish the outer alignment for content.
- Dividers and spacing buffers enable information to be stacked and listed, clearly distinguishing directions from destinations or mapping.



Principles: typesetting

Typesetting is a unique part of the SMG brand identity. Wayfinding where possible adopts stylistic typesetting increasing coherency between brand and signage. Where needed in line weight, scale or orientation may be enhanced to suit the requirements of wayfinding where needed.

- Signature typesetting (black to light weight) is used for identification signage of the museum + areas unique to it:
 - Area name identifier = Upper case, V-aligned
 - Building identifier = Upper case, V-aligned
 - Attraction identifier = Upper case, H-aligned
 - Hall identifier = Upper case, H–or V–aligned
 - Museum identifier = Upper case H-or V-aligned.
- Primary typesetting (regular/medium weight) is used for identification signage of common areas, as well as for directional, informative or statutory signage:
 - Statutory info = Sentence case, centre-aligned
 - Overview info = Sentence case, left-aligned.
 - Facility direction = Sentence case, outer-aligned
 - Attraction direction = Sentence case, outer-aligned
 - Exit/Hall direction = Upper case, outer-aligned
 - Access identifier = Upper case, outer-aligned
- Where content is aligned vertically, it should be read from bottom up, and ideally with the baseline placed closest to the entrance.









Signature typesetting: For identification signage

Used on identification signage only, when identifying areas unique to the museum (halls, zones, attractions).

Typically illuminated, transitioning in weight (Black to Light).

May be displayed horizontal or vertical format.



Primary typesetting:

Wayfinding signage

SMG REGULAR (UPPER CASE)

Used on directional, informative, statutory and exit signage, as well as identification of common areas only.

Common area

Typically one weight (Bold or Regular) in uppercase or sentence case dependent on content type.

May be displayed horizontally only.



Appendix : New Hall coordination

Following the most recent coordination meeting with AOC and the site visit with Nationwide, it has been agreed that the donor recognition panel will remain in the location shown in the tender issue, by the main entrance after the windows, and that a suspended panel per aisle will proceed for signage to direct towards toilets.

The following page uses elevations from the architect to demonstrate the principle of placement for these panels, which will be adjusted on site. Suspended panels will sit above interpretation, and below rod lighting at between 2.4–2.5m above F/L. Panels will be suspended from the beams behind CCTV cameras where applicable to avoid obstruction of sightlines.
