Design:

No change to existing wall.

Replacement of existing square-holed trellis-style fencing with spaced horizontal slatted-style fencing to same height.

Additional square-holed trellis style fencing 1m above existing wall line as agreed.

Reason for re-design:

Following removal of a large, overgrown and sprawling ivy by the owners of no.9 that had also spread along our property boundary by some 9ft, the existing trellis-style fencing, and solid-style fencing was damaged beyond repair. It was unsightly and no longer fit for the security of our property, nor for the safety of our dog, thus causing a nuisance and reducing the enjoyment of our property. As well as having neighbouring boundaries to no.9, a Grade II listed building, our properties each have a perpendicular separating boundary where our previous solid-style fencing was also damaged beyond repair.

Access:

No change of access.

Heritage:

This has little or no significance to the listed building (no.9) next door to our property. It does not touch the listed building and so in no way affects the structural or appearance of the building itself. The new design would in fact be lower than the height of the ivy, significantly opening up the view of no.9, letting in considerably more natural light and be a reduction in the density imposed by the previous ivy. Our property is situated to the rear of the listed building where only the small number of immediate neighbours using the shared private driveway view it. All these neighbours commented that they were in favour of the new design and removal of the overgrown ivy as it also improved the ease of access to their properties.
