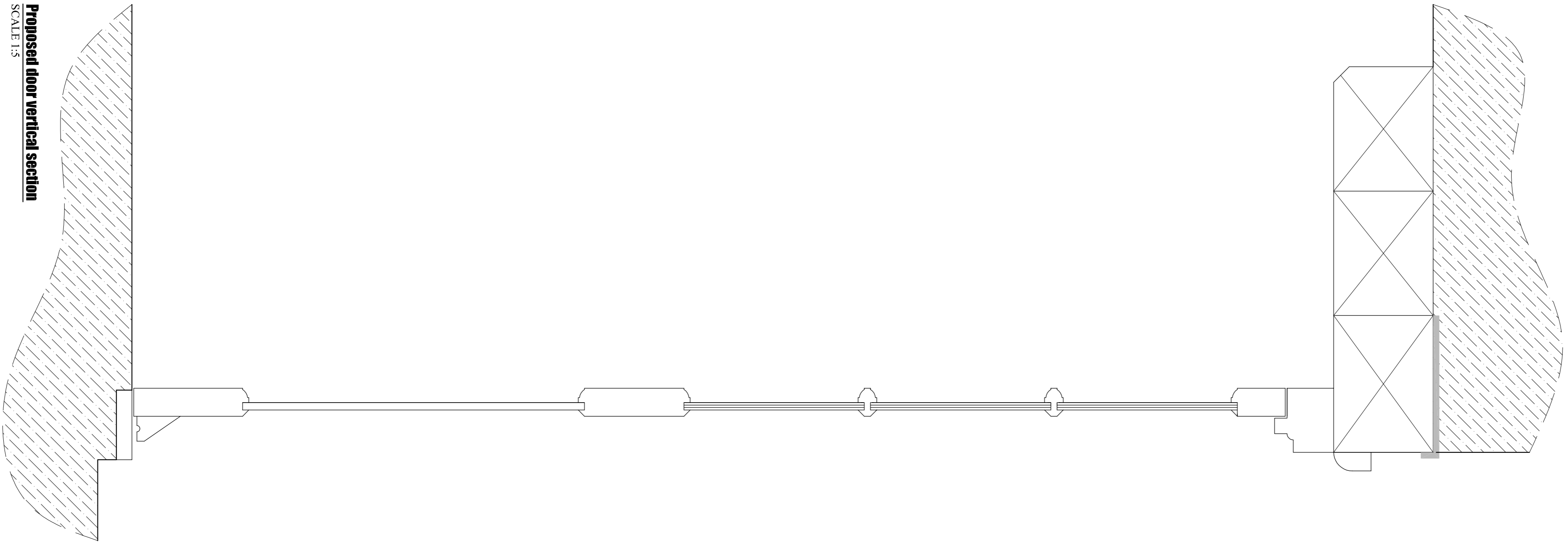
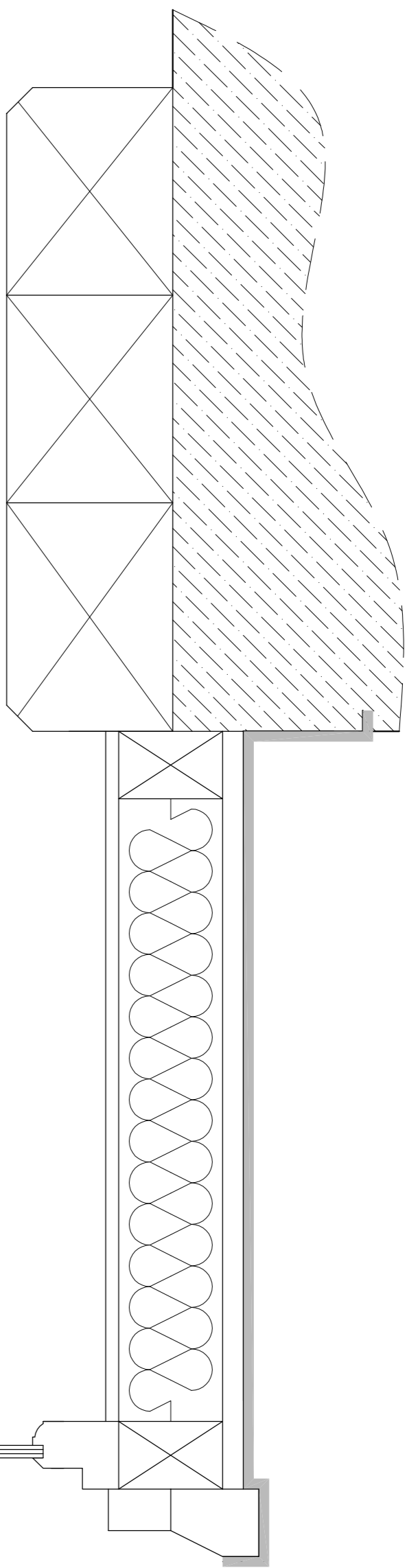


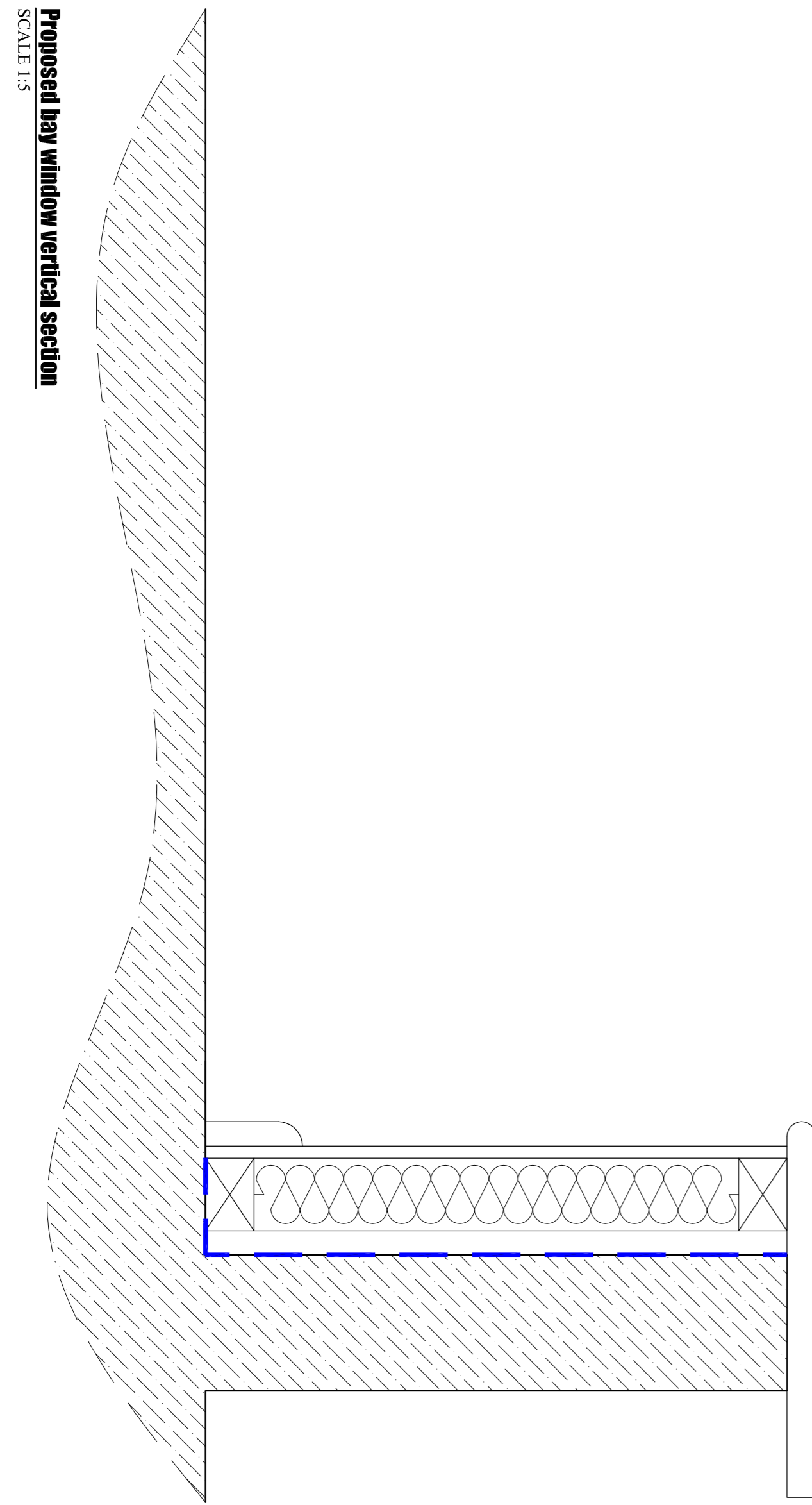
# PROPOSED BAY WINDOW AND DOOR VERTICAL SECTIONS



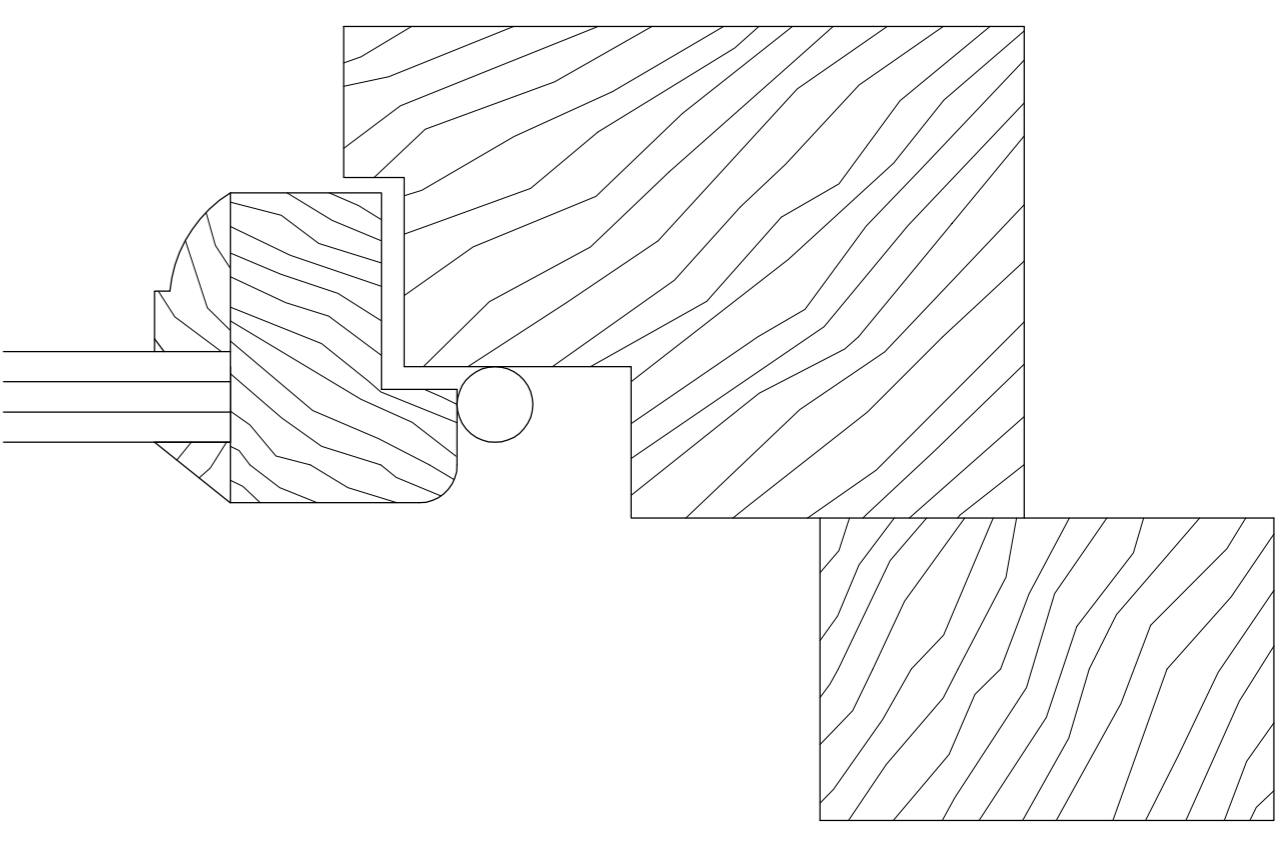
**Proposed floor vertical section**

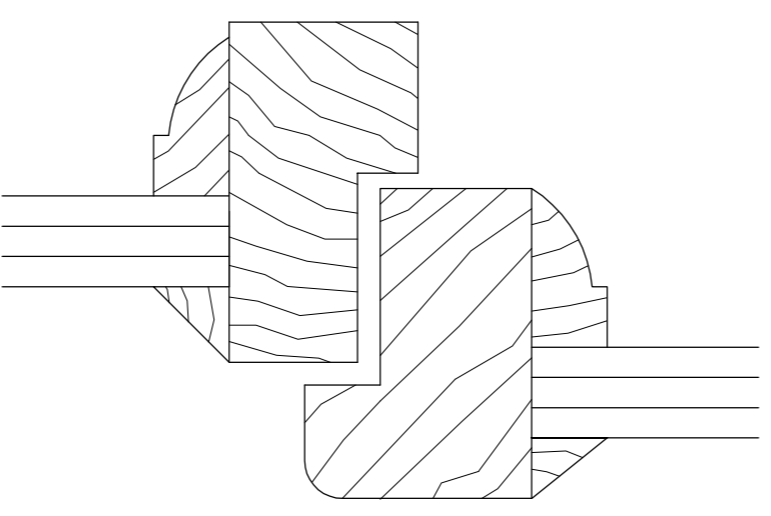


**Proposed bay window frame opening casement section**
