I've found a note in Kirsty's file that the following system would be used. Is this still the case?

I've followed the link and (it being on the limestone in Ketton) the most appropriate mix might be number 7 – chalk grassland. However, I would like to check the composition of the mix, and there is no info about this on Bauder's website. Could the applicant get back to me with some more details? – and confirmation of the supplier they are suing with ink to website, if not Bauder. Bauder do seem suitable, being endorsed by Buglife and flora locale.
