We acknowledge receipt of your application for the above which was received at Warwick District Council on 20 December, 2023. In the absence of such notification the proposed work may go ahead as long as it is carried out within two years from the date of the application. In addition, if you are not the owner of the land, please ensure that you have obtained consent from the landowner on which the tree(s) sits before carrying out any works.
