


The chimneys with modern cement render in poor condition due to water held behind render. During repair work to remove cement render the brickwork was found to be in a very poor condition and the chimneys were deemed structurally unsafe.

ASSESSMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE The chimneys are a significant element in terms of historic style and form. Modern cement based renders are damaging to brickwork and should be removed






EAST ELEVATION



The log store roof structure was a mix of old The log store roof structure was a mix of old and new timber. There was extensive rot in the old timber. See Photos right. The structure of the log store has heritage significance as part of the traditional form of construction, but the amount of rot meant that repair was un-viable. Replacement on a like-for-like basis follows good conservation principals
