



Dear Sir,

I have a large conifer tree that has been damaged in the recent storm. A large branch came down onto my neighbours Alpaca shelter. Fortunately there was little damage and no injuries. I have managed to get a tree surgeon in to remove the branch and was told that it had weakened the main trunk. He has tried as best he can to make it safe, but said another strong storm could bring the rest down causing damage. I do not want the tree felled but would like it to be reduce by half to make it safe. This is an urgent request and hope you will give permission for the work to be carried out as soon as possible. I have attached a photo of the tree.
