
## Application to fell a silver birch @ 30 White Rose Ave New Earswick TO 32 4AG (contd)

. That it may be blown down in the increasing high winds. This would cause servins damage to our house, or to our neighbours', for which, according to our house insusance, we would be responsible.

We feel the tree is too close to the house and to the common sewer (approx (maway) that runs along the back of the houses an the east side of White Rose Ave.

There are three large trees in our neighbours garden on the south boundary (see nos 2. 3 and 4 on the accompany's dragram). These trees already block significant surlight from our jarden. However we are keen to create a Jegetable patch and to plant fruit trees and fruit sishes (apple pear, plum, fig, guice, raspheries, blackourrants and blueberies), and we expect that the extra light coming into the garden by felling the silver birch will enable os to do this. The loss of the sirch tree vill also retain more mutients in the soil, create more space, and leave more water in the ground for othe trees and plants, We will replace the silver sirch by either one of the fruit trees or a small wildlife pond. We will decide Mich ophon when we see how big a space is created ance the root still has seen removed. We would be happy fingen to come all and Nic Franklin-Woolley
