In satisfaction of the relevant condition, I set out below details of the replacement, more historically appropriate, fireplace and where it will be sourced from. In essence, in circumstances where the house dates from the early 18th century, and having consulted Holly Rowland of Bidwells and reviewed among other things, the Georgian Group's guide to Georgian fireplaces (see https://georgiangroup.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2018/05/The_Georgian_Group_Guides_N9_Fireplaces-s.pdf), the most appropriate solution appears to be to install a simple bolection chimneypiece in appropriate stone.

After much research and having liaised with Susan Smith, Principal Conservation Officer at Greater Cambridge Shared Planning, and in circumstances where it has not been possible to find a suitable reclaim fireplace, I have worked with Uppingham Stone (https://www.uppinghamstone.co.uk/about) to reproduce a simple bolection design which I had identified in suitable dimensions and stone (a copy of the design is uploaded with this application). It is proposed that the fire surround will be carved and constructed out of Ancaster Hard White Limestone (see https://www.uppinghamstone.co.uk/stone) which is quarried near Grantham in Lincolnshire and has been used extensively in Cambridge and the surrounding area for centuries (see e.g. https://goldholme.com/history-stone/the-stones-that-built-cambridge/#:~:text=Ancaster%20played%20an%20important%20role,at%20Gonville%20and%20Caius%20College).
