APPLICATION FOR DISCHARGE OF CONDITION(S) - DC/24/00064 Proposal: Discharge of Conditions Application for DC/23/02006 - Condition 3 (Landscaping Scheme) 5 (Management of Manure) and 6 (Management of Run-off) Location: Valley Farm, Flowton Road, Flowton, Ipswich Suffolk IP8 4LH

The information included is sufficient to discharge 3 and 5.

The information does not give sufficient detail to discharge condition 6 as the manure is intended to be left exposed to weather which may overcome the ability of the absorbent materials to prevent water run off, the trailer does not have a sealed base to prevent this waste escape onto the concrete storage area and the storage area has no method to collect and treat this run off.

A method to prevent weather ingress, prevent escape of water waste before transportation and use, or a method of interception and treatment to the storage area would discharge this condition.
