Dear Wendy,

Further to your letter of 3rd January 2024 I have attached a revised site plan showing the location of six significant trees marked A-F this is to continue the identification used in the original application (A & B).

Tree A is a domestic apple. The proposal is to reduce the crown by 1.5mts (50%) to create a balanced compact crown.

Tree B is a Weeping Silver Birch. The proposal is to remove minor deadwood from the crown.

Tree C is a Cherry sp. Remove due to a poor form and its location close to the watercourse.

Tree D is a Goat Willow. Remove as the tree is self-seeded and an unsuitable species for its location close to the building.

Tree E is a Poplar sp. Remove as the tree is self-seeded and an unsuitable species for its location close to the building.

Tree F is a Poplar sp. Multi-stemmed coppiced specimen. Remove as the species is unsuitable for its location close to the building.

The stem diameter of the self-seeded ash and hawthorn referred to in the application are less than 10cm measured at 1.5mts. above ground level.

Please confirm this additional information is sufficiently detailed to allow the application to be processed.
