AIR NAVIGATION ORDER 2016
PERMISSION U19-06-0503



1. The Civil Aviation Authority, pursuant to article 92(2)(a)(ii) of the Air Navigation Order 2016, hereby permits any captive unmanned gas filled balloon, hereinafter called "the balloon", being operated by **Imagine Inflatables Ltd / Netmatters Ltd** to be flown at or above 60 metres above ground level.
2. This Permission is granted subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) the balloon shall only be flown from **Unit 15, Penfold Drive, Gateway 11 Business Park, Wymondham, Norfolk, NR18 0WZ; OS Grid Ref.: TG 126 021;**
 - (b) the balloon shall not be flown above **200** feet above ground level;
 - (c) the balloon shall only be flown in weather conditions which enable it to remain at least 1800 metres horizontally and 1000 feet vertically away from cloud, and in a visibility of at least 5 kilometres;
 - (d) **during the hours of darkness, the balloon must be lit;**
 - (e) the balloon shall not be left unattended unless it is fitted with a device which ensures **immediate** automatic deflation should it break free of its moorings;
 - (f) in the event that the balloon does break free of its moorings, and not promptly deflate, the Operator **MUST** immediately inform both Air Traffic Control (ATC) at **Norwich Airport, Tel: 01603 420641,** and the local Police, of the last observed height and direction of drift of the balloon, and approximate cable length trailing. **If a reasonable time has elapsed without answer from the above ATC Unit, the Operator should telephone the Watch Supervisor at London Area Control (Swanwick), Tel: 01489 612420.** In addition, a FULL report in writing **must** then be submitted to CAA Airspace Regulation at arops@caa.co.uk;
 - (g) **the contact telephone number (07909 924188) must be manned throughout each period of flying.**
3. This Permission shall have effect **0700 – 1900** local time daily, **between 12-Jun-19 and 12-Jun-20**, unless previously revoked, varied or suspended.
4. The on-site Operator shall have this Permission in their possession at all times during flight.
