

## East Kent Light Railway cutting





The railway cutting formed part of the East Kent Light Railway which served the local collieries in this part of east Kent. The single track line ran to Guilford Colliery Coldred through to Richborough Port, the colliery was finally abandoned in 1921 having never produced coal. The cutting was originally a crisp rectilinear shape as can be seen in the picture taken before the lines were removed in 1937. The line was partially re-laid during the Second World War but later fell derelict.
