Good Afternoon,

Please find the map with the yew group marked up on it - in the same place as on my original sketch.

I have not notified or requested for any work to be carried out to the Horse Chestnut so did not include it in the work proposal. It is simply noted on my sketch so that the rest of the trees can be more easily identified by location.

Item 12 - 8 trees in total. Laterally crown reduce by 1 to 2 mtrs. This is to maintain the size appropriate to the garden and allow light to adjacent plants.

Item 21 - Prune or remove congested branches by crown thinning by 10 - 15%. To reform the canopy shape and structure.

Hopefully the above clarifies your questions.

We refer to your application in respect of the above, please annotate the attached map to show where the Yew belt is located and return to this email address


The Horse Chestnut on the proposal is subject to a Tree Preservation order and will be split from the conservation area application.
