Regarding Chestnut Tree (T4) in application DC/23/05769 at 18 Bullen Close.

T4 is a Re generation from an old coppice stool. There is significant decay around the base area and some large cavities at low level. The main area of concern is the co-dominant stems. There is included bark with signs of decay and separation. If separation occurs there is a high risk of damage to the house. I have suggested fell due to high risk of damage from a poor specimen of tree. Please see photos attached.
