On completion of installation of new roof edge protection & new PV array, existing man safe system to be removed & flat roof membrane made good and suitably sealed at the anchor points. New planters introduced @ main entrance to building to give entrance separation from pavement & public circulation. Existing columns at front of building to be painted dark grey to match existing low level brickwork.
