I have had a quick chat with the Conservation Officer and, whilst she would prefer the white background as this would blend in better with the
white of the colonnade, there would not be any objections to either of these colour schemes.
I just wanted to clarify that advertisement consent would be required for this signage as it involves an illuminated sign in a Conservation Area
and I would also recommend that this lighting is included in the listed building consent application to be submitted. The use of swan neck
lights is likely to be acceptable in principle as there are others in The Pantiles but we will require specifications of the exact lights to be
submitted with the applications. They do appear fairly large (although this may be due to the photomontage) and the Conservation Officer did wonder whether there was a need for three in comparison to the size of the sign.
