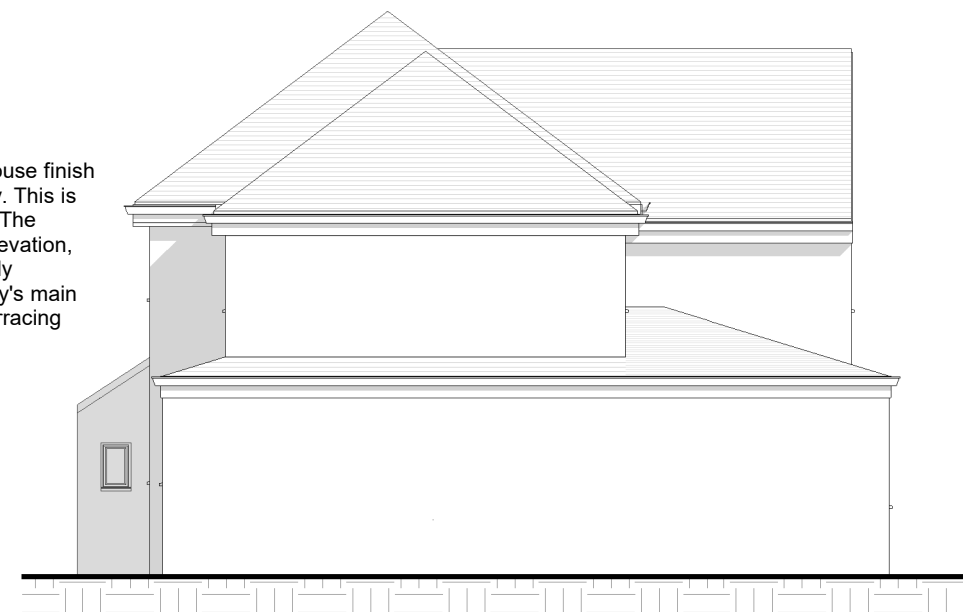
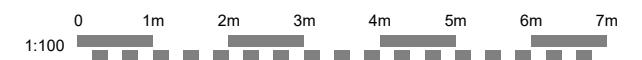
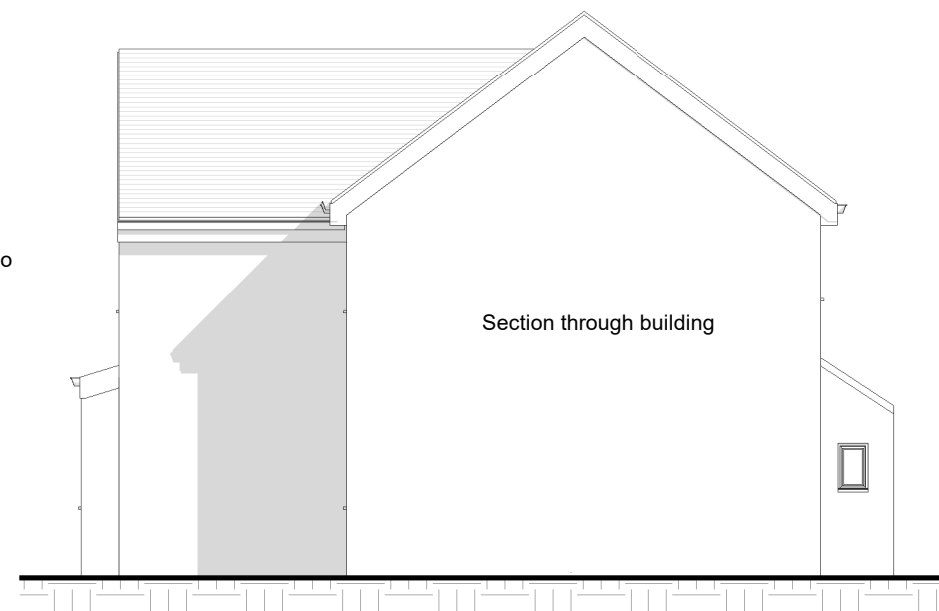




The proposed side extension finish matches the existing house finish and is reasonably sets back from the neighbouring property. This is to minimise the impact of overbearing and overshadowing. The proposed first floor is sets back by 1 meter from the front elevation, and sets back from the side boundary as much as practically possible. The roof would be set down from the host property's main ridge. This will ensure visual subservience and minimise terracing appearance effect.
