Bay & Bow Windows

ADVANCE 70 bay and bow windows are created by combining three or more windows together so that they angle out beyond the house wall. They can be casement, flush sash or tilt and turn depending on your needs. By using more windows, bay and bow windows allow more light in and also give you extra space inside your room.

Bay windows are perhaps the more common of the two reinforced window styles and generally consist of three windows of varying sizes. The central panel is often the largest, allowing for the best view, and this is then backed up by two panels, known as flankers, that are smaller in size and positioned at an angle.

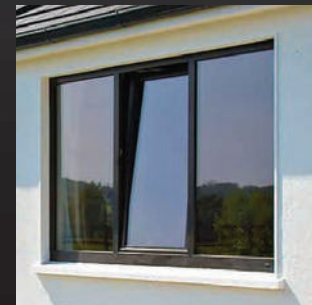
Unlike bay windows, bow windows can generally consist of anywhere between three and six panels and they are generally all the same size. While the angles used in bay windows are often pronounced, the number of window panels used in bow windows create a more curved look.

Tilt & Turn Windows

ADVANCE 70 tilt and turn windows are a highly versatile and practical window option. Simplistically designed with their great multi-functional operation, which makes them stand out from the norm.

Tilt and turn operation makes them easily accessible from the inside of your property, where access externally may be difficult. The windows have two distinct functions of being able to have the opening set to a tilt function, to allow for air flow and restrict access or you are able to fully open the window in to the inside of your home.

The ability to fully open the window in to the internal space, allows for easy cleaning and maintenance of tilt and turn windows, one of the major reasons for choosing them when access to the external side of the window proves a problem.

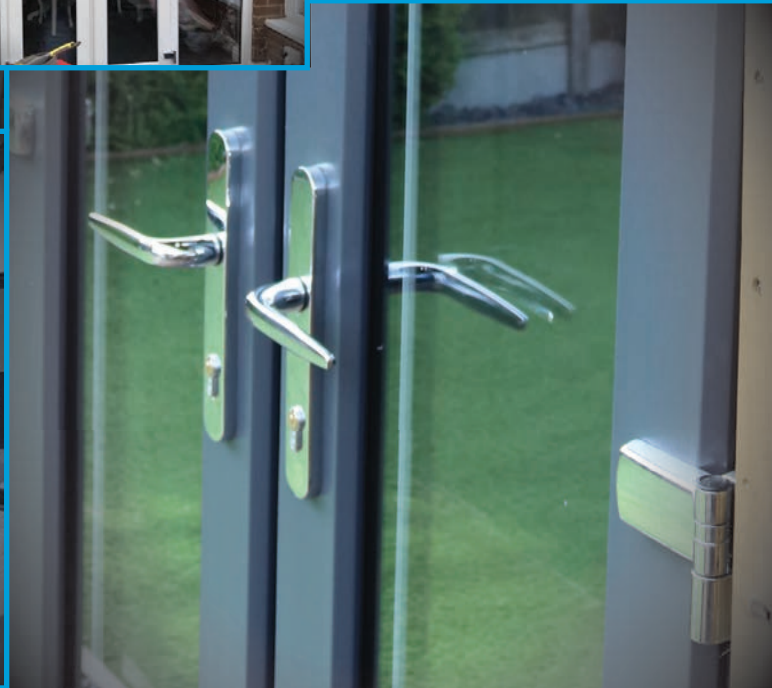
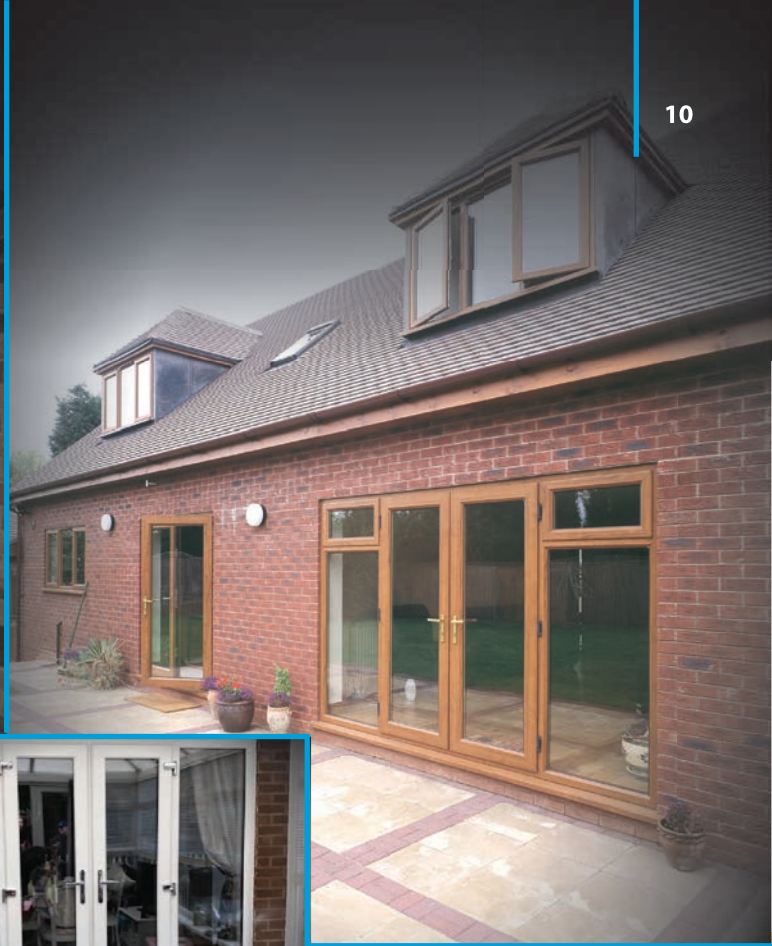

Homeowners tend to opt for the gable front to create both a fantastic external and internal aesthetic look.

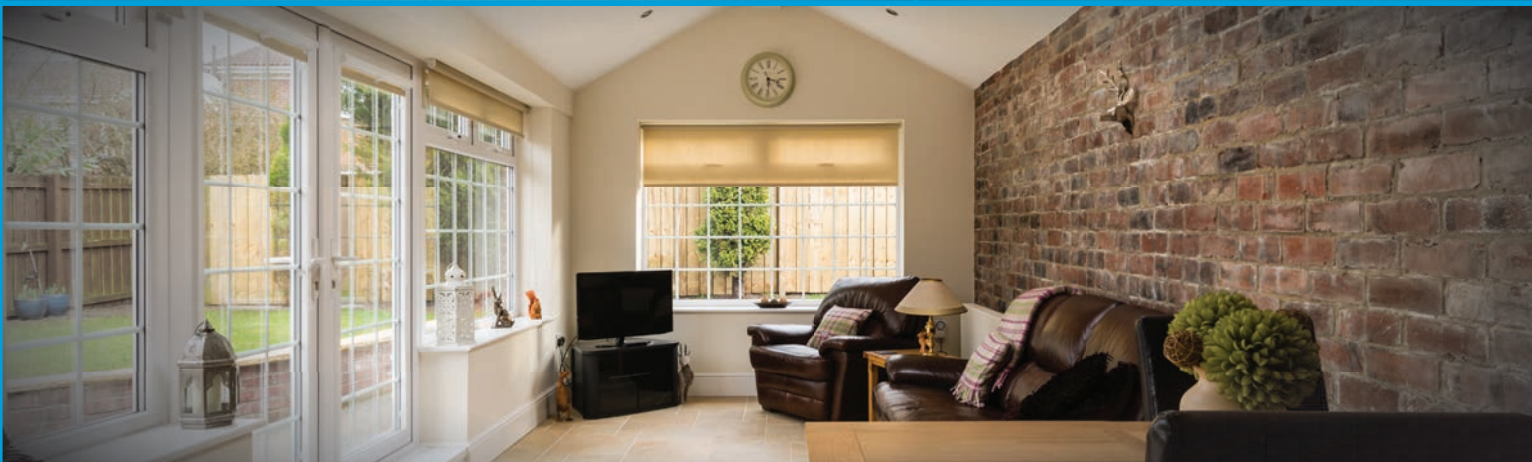
The gable front design is an installation with a classic, spacious feel. The extra space inside the property is just one of the benefits, as the style transforms any garden with a smooth and shiny exterior.

The high security window and door locking system options are compliant with PAS 24, Document Q and Secured by Design, which ticks all the boxes when it comes to enhanced security.

Energy Efficiency

Modern PVCu also benefits from excellent thermal performance levels. The ADVANCE 70 System is one of the leading performers with its 5 chambered system and Recycled Thermal Reinforcement (RTR Bar) providing you with A+ rated options to keep the cold out and warmth in.

These qualities put the ADVANCE 70 Window and Door System at the forefront of technological performance, ensuring that your home is secure and warm for many years to come.

What are window (and door) energy ratings?

A window or doors rating is determined by a formula which takes into account the total solar heat transmittance, the amount of the sun's heat which can pass through the glass (usually referred to as g-value); the U-value of the whole unit (frame and glass combined), how well the window or door keeps the heat in your home; and the air infiltration through the window or door seals.

To make the Rating standard across all products, a standard window / door size and configuration is used. The resulting value is then placed into a band on the scale G-A, with A-rated windows and doors being the most energy-efficient.

Did You Know?

UK Burglary Statistics

In **72%** of cases, the burglar will enter through a door, of which...

27% by forcing the lock or cylinder
15% through an unlocked door
10% by breaking the door or door panel
5% enter the property with a key

In **26%** of cases the burglar will enter through a window, of which...

11% force the window lock or latch
9% cut through or break the glass
6% will enter through an already open window

This means that **48%** of burglaries are owing to inferior windows and doors!

Sustainability

PVCu windows and doors have a long and low maintenance lifespan, which can see them **last up to 30-40 years**.

What is more impressive, is the high quality reuse of PVCu, where it can be **recycled up to 10 times**, meaning a single window or door has a **new life expectancy of 350 years!**



PAS 24 Windows & Doors



ADVANCE 70 Windows & Doors use high security locking systems, tested to PAS 24 & Secured By Design standards...

An inferior window or door locking system can be manipulated, snapped, picked, drilled or bumped to gain access to your property in less than 30 seconds! This is why our ADVANCE 70 system uses tried and tested security hardware on our windows and doors.

So what are my Enhanced Security options?

An Enhanced Security option is compliant with PAS 24 and Secured by Design. This means that the complete and fully manufactured window or door has been rigorously and independently tested by a UKAS accredited test house.

The PAS 24 standard is an extra security measure to ensure windows and doors are up to the security standards, in case you do so happen to have a break in. The testing is based on a burglar trying to manipulate a cylinder, cut-through a slab or panel or force the lock and/or hinge side of a door. On a window forcing entry through the locking points using a selection of tools including 'crow bars', screwdrivers, chisels, drills and blades.

Secured by Design (SBD) is the official police security initiative that works to improve the security of buildings and their immediate surroundings to provide safe places to live, work, shop and visit.

SBD's product based accreditation scheme – the Police Preferred Specification - provides a recognised standard for all security products that can deter and reduce crime.



A Rated Windows & Doors

The window and door profiles used to make the frames for your home offer excellent thermal insulation, as the gaskets and weathertight seals shut out draughts while the glazing reflects the heat back in to your room.

The multiple chambers within the profiles and the option of using Recycled Thermal Reinforcement (RTR) Bar also greatly improves the heat loss from your home. Aspects that will greatly reduce energy bills.

The benefits of energy-efficient windows (and doors!)

Smaller energy bills: replacing all single-glazed windows with A-rated double glazing could save you around £160 per year on your energy bills.

A smaller carbon footprint: by using less fuel, you'll generate less of the carbon dioxide that leads to global warming - typically, 680kg a year.

A more comfortable home: energy-efficient glazing reduces heat loss through windows and means fewer draughts and cold spots.
Peace and quiet: as well as keeping the heat in, energy efficient windows insulate your home against outside noise.

Reduced condensation: energy-efficient glazing reduces condensation build-up on the inside of windows.

The costs and savings for energy-efficient glazing will be different for each home and each window, depending on the size, material and installer. Double glazing should last for 20 years or more.

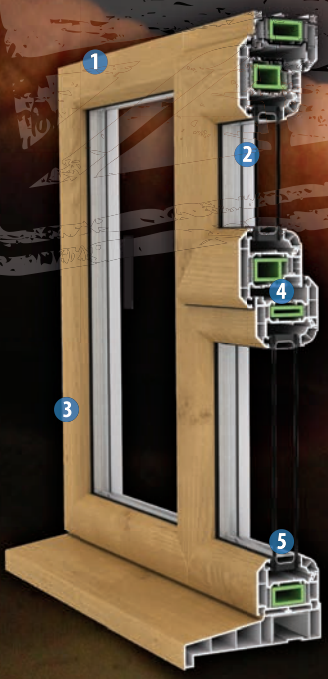

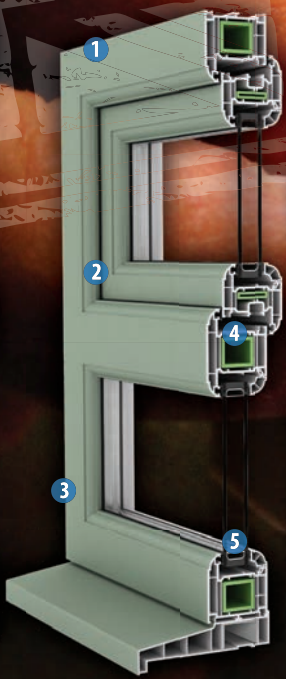
