Proposed Building Materials

Site Adjacent to Yew Tree Cottage School Lane Takeley Bishop's Stortford, Essex CM22 6PJ

BRICKWORK

The proposed brick for the brick plinth is TBS Audley Antique. The bond of the brickwork is to be Flemish bond (laid header/stretcher alternatively).

RENDER

The proposed render is to be K Rend in Polar White with a scraped finish.

SLATES

The proposed slate for the roof areas is to be Cupa Pizarras No.8. from the Novo Mormiau quarry in Caralleda (Orense), Galicia, Spain. The colour is grey and the texture is flat. The size is 500mm x 250mm x 5mm thick nominally.

WINDOWS AND DOORS

The proposed windows and doors are to be constructed in timber with a white painted finish. See drawing C488/BR/07 for details. The window style is flush casement with horizontal and vertical glazing bars.

GUTTERS AND DOWNPIES

The proposed rainwater goods are to be Alumasc Heritage range finished in black. The gutters are to be 113mm HR2 Heritage Half Round. The downpipes are to be 75mm RW2 Circular. All brackets, corners and bends etc. are to selected to suit the HR2 and RW2 components.

FASCIAS, BARGEBOARDS AND SOFFITES

The proposed fascias, bargeboards and soffites are to be construced in timber with a white painted finish.
