

Reasons for Work Statement

The subject Oak trees are growing strongly towards the north and Finch House, due to shading by other trees on the boundary of the allotments on Bullbeggars Lane. A number of branches are causing concern that overhang Finch House garden and extending towards the house. The branches in question cast shade and are causing the trees to lean towards the property. Growth over the next few years may well cause the trees to lean further and increase the possibility of damage due to falling branches and lopsided growth.

Additionally following the removal of tree T004 – TPO/0002/2007 (a large twin bole diseased Oak to the south west of trees 1 & 3), by Woking Council in July 2022, the protection for T001 & T003 has been reduced exacerbating the above concerns.

The work requested is to prune up to 3 meters of growth from the North side of Trees T001 & T002 which overhang Finch House garden.
