1. INTRODUCTION

This planning conditions discharge application has been prepared following the approval of planning application DC/2023/01601 for the installation of new shop frontage and the provision of a new accessible ramp to the front.

As part of the planning permission, the Local Planning Authority (LPA) (Sefton) decided to attach 3 precommencement planning conditions (2, 4, and 5), which require the submission of materials and colour details before work can start on site This application seeks to discharge those planning conditions.

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Condition 4) No development shall commence until details of the proposed colour scheme are submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

Condition 5) No development shall commence until details of the new door are submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.
