## **SCREENING OPINION**

## Application Reference: 24/00215/TCONR

**Description Of Proposed Development :** T1: Small Poplar. Removal. T2: Small Mespilus Germanica (Common Medlar). This tree had a lower limb resting on a drystone wall. This limb needs removal as it's causing damage to the wall. Also to thin out the congested areas of the crown.

Location: Crabtree Cottage Duntisbourne Leer Cirencester Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 23 January 2024 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation. Having considered the criteria stated within Schedule 3 the Local Planning Authority concludes that it will have no significant environmental effects having regard to its nature, size and location and therefore **will not** require the submission of an Environmental Impact Assessment.
