This will be communicated immediately to onsite security staff. The hope is this would prevent any break in or vandalism to any part of the building.

The installed cameras around the courtyard will be done as sympathetically as possible to the building. We have chosen black cameras and locations that will do its best to blend into the surroundings and building. All cabling will be running through the roof space and out of site.

The proposed works will help the estate sustain the historic value of the buildings at Thoresby Courtyard especially in detecting any vandalism around the site.
