Thanks for coming back to me so quickly.

G3 – Cut back over hanging. As G3 refers to a group of trees can you please state how many of the trees you are proposing to cut back and specify the distance you are proposing to cut back by.

All thee trees are 5m+ over my boundary so my proposal is to back 5m.

T9 and T10 – can you also specify the amount you are proposing to cut back the over hanging by.

I am proposing T9 5m, T10 4m.

Did the photo link work in the previous email?

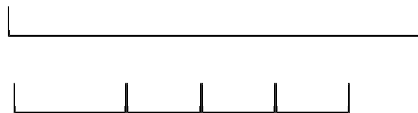

Dear Planning Office

Please see attached an application for tree works which includes tree identification using the preservation order, and preservation order map.

Also attached is the original preservation order, and a tree report compiled by Heritage Tree Specialists.

I have previously submitted photos to [REDACTED] - please can you confirm you have these on file still and will add them to this application.

**The protection order in question is 2/TPO00380 (1B Avon Road is not mentioned on the order as its a new house so I have drawn it on)**

The application is based on two neighbouring properties, each have trees on their land that hang over my boundary significantly causing the below issues:

**1B Avon Road, South Wootton, PE30 3LS: G3 – Scots Pine x 3**

Trees leaning over, 2m+ reaching past my chimney which I feel is a huge fire risk.

Pigeons in trees excrement all over my side due to far hanging branches

The mess covers our cars on a daily basis having blocked water vessels on my BMW - caused a big leak into car boot, blocking gutters. We can't park our cars near the trees !

**46 Nursery Lane, South Wootton, PE30 3LR - T9, T10**

Pigeons in trees excrement all over my side due to far hanging branches.

Excessive amount of leaves, branches and pine needles dropping to a point where it's like a layer of snow covering the grass!

T9 & T10 3m+ hanging over my side - directly below this area is totally covered in excrement making the area unhygienic and unusable.

We are washing / sterilizing patio on a weekly basis, paying gardeners to clear grab bags of leaves each week. Kids and dog constantly stepping in bird excrement and bringing it into the house.

Light is being blocked, making the whole situation a depressing dark vibe of bird excrement and my neighbours leaves and branches. The situation is causing us stress and anxiety, having spent a fortune on the house and feeling like we are living in a forest. The matter is also very expensive to resolve on a temporary basis with no end in sight.

I will be contacting environment health regarding the pigeon excrement as its disgusting / soul destroying constantly cleaning this up from your kids and dog feet, patio and kitchen floor. I think it's worth me speaking with the fire brigade for their view on the chimney issue.

Please can you advise me if you intend to contact the neighbours, I would like to speak with them first.

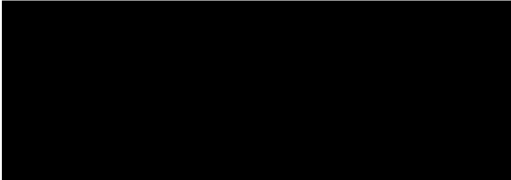

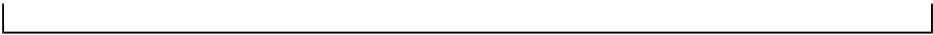
