

Design and Access Statement

Introduction

The proposal is for outside seating to “MeCycle” located at 59 Station Road Ainsdale. The layout of the design includes 3 bench table seating to each Chesterfield Rd and on Station Road as previously approved but now lapsed application - surrounded by advertised guarding and planters.

Its location and size of pavement allows this to actually add value to the appearance of the surrounding area and be a service to the local community.

Use:

To use tables and chairs surrounded by guarding which will benefit the area by creating a sociable atmosphere. Also to try and increase sales to counteract the effects the pandemic has had on the business. We need to create more revenue to ensure the business stays viable. Seating area to be used within the hours of 08.00 – 20.00 Monday to Sunday as stated in conditions of previously approved applications DC/2015/01182 and DC/2023/01590

Amount:

The area proposed for the seating will be guarded using 1100mm high metal pedestrian guard rail and 1000mm high planters which will help secure the guarding rail. The proposed seating will be situated close to the glazed frontage leaving passage for customers and waiters/waitresses.

Layout:

The layout has been considered to allow people to move between the tables and for employees to safely wait-on seated customers.

Scale:

The development will run approximately the full length of the building’s façade on Chesterfield Road and Station road leaving access into the main building and to No 59A

Access:

Access to the restaurant shall remain as existing and access to the seating will be provided by an opening in the guarding adjacent to the shop front.
