**Description Of Proposed Development :** Non material amendment to permission of 22/03112/FUL - Demolition of single garage and erection of 2 storey side extension and single storey rear extension and other associated works

Location: The Steps 30 Great Rissington Cheltenham Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 23 January 2024 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.
