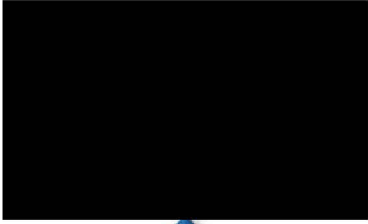

The European Larch tree has unfortunately been uprooted in the winds and is now being supported in a pine tree. Photographs attached show the root plate lifted and the lean of the tree. The garden is extensively covered in trees and will offer little light to a replacement planting, this particular tree has been suppressed and would have been removed due to spacing had it been a woodland environment.
