Description: T1 - Sycamore. Crown Raise to 6 metres. The majority of the lower

limbs, which directly overhand the adjacent road & private driveway, are dead. Recommendation for crown raise to 6 metres to remove all

dead & damaged lower limbs.

T2 - Sycamore. Complete removal. This mature tree leans directly over the adjacent road & power lines, and towards the neighbour's

property.

T3 - Ash. Complete removal. Clear signs of Ash die-back disease. T3 is located adjacent to T2 and thus presents similar cause for

concern.
