

Dear Mr Posaner,

Re: Survey of trees near roads near No26 Main Street, Woodborough

Via East Midlands on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council is responsible for the management of all the trees, hedges and shrubs growing within the adopted highway. Trees, hedges and shrubs are maintained to reduce the risk of harm to people and property to a safe level and to discharge the Councils duties under law in dealing with a statutory nuisance.

If a potentially dangerous **private** tree is identified by our officers. We have a duty to ensure that the private owner of the tree is informed of any potential danger that could have an impact on the highway and that the private owner in question must take the necessary action to remove or contain the potential danger as appropriate.

A recent survey in your area has identified a tree, which is likely to be dangerous to road users. I have attached a plan showing relevant tree within your property where there appears to be a likelihood of danger.

The tree is shown on the attached plan marked with a purple marker and photos below.

Please contact me as soon as possible (but in any event within 7 days of receipt of this letter) to arrange a short meeting. We can view the trees and discuss the best way of dealing with any likelihood of any danger.
