


or even in view of a road or a public walkway, just overlooking garages and parking area. So, I then installed close board fencing to the side boundary at a height ranging from 2.000M to 2.400M(because of the difference in ground levels) and also the rear boundary fence at a height of 2.000M(used this height to match in with new replacement rear gate). I then installed hit and miss trellis above the rear fence (this ended up at 1.000M, keeping in eye line of other rear fences), the height of the rear fence with trellis is now 3.000M, this then gave me privacy and security to my rear garden again. If my rear fence was at 2.000M in height I could not even sit down on my patio for a cup of tea without being in full view of anyone using the garages and parking area to the rear of my property (due to the afore mentioned drop in height over short distance of the ground levels). When you look at the rear of the properties all the rear fences are virtually all at the same level, so my fence does not look out of keeping with the other properties in this row of houses (I have supplied photographs showing this). A couple of years ago my neighbour had a break in during the daytime, because of this, I have now installed a CCTV camera onto the top of the hit and miss trellis which now covers this rear area.

I have also supplied a signed statement from all of my neighbours saying that they have no concerns or objections to the height or appearance of my boundary fences whatsoever.

I am sorry if this letter seems long winded but I wanted to put forward all the facts concerning my boundary fences and reasons for the height, also my rear fence is actually 200mm inside the rear boundary of my property.

I hope that after taking everything into account that you see fit to grant me Retrospective Planning Permission for my boundary fences, thus giving me privacy and security once again.
