TREE AND BIODIVERSITY STATEMENT

With regard to the trees on the photos, these are currently actively being removed (most have already gone) due to safety concerns and prior weather damage. All remaining trees will be removed in the coming days.

Regarding an ecology survey, we would suggest that this is unreasonable and unnecessary in this instance. The site has been completely stripped and cleared of all scrub and vegetation, as the entirety of the holding was overgrown upon purchase. The site demonstrably has no biodiversity value.
