NOTIFICATION UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (TREE PRESERVATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 – PART 3

REFERENCE NO: 24/00248/DDTPO
PROPOSAL: (TPO.TVBC.140) - T1, T2, T3, T5 - Fell dangerous Silver Birches, T4 - Fell dead Silver Birch, located next to the boundary line north east of the farm building
LOCATION: Test Valley Farm, Little Drove Road, Chilbolton, Stockbridge

Further to your notification received on 5th February 2024, I am able to confirm that the trees are of a condition to fulfil the description of being dangerous for the purposes of Regulation 14 (1) (c) of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012. This exemption allows you to carry out such works as are urgently necessary to remove an immediate risk of serious harm without further notification to, or consent from, this authority.

I would be grateful if you could email planning@testvalley.gov.uk when you know the date of the proposed felling. The legislation places a duty upon landowners to plant replacement trees for those removed under this exemption. Therefore, I would be grateful if you could confirm that you will be planting another tree, which should be of the same species as that which has been felled and planted close to the stump of the original tree unless otherwise agreed in writing with this Authority. The replacement trees should be planted at the time of felling or during the first planting season (November to April) following the felling.
