I am requesting to apply for a 5 day notice for the pruning of some trees.

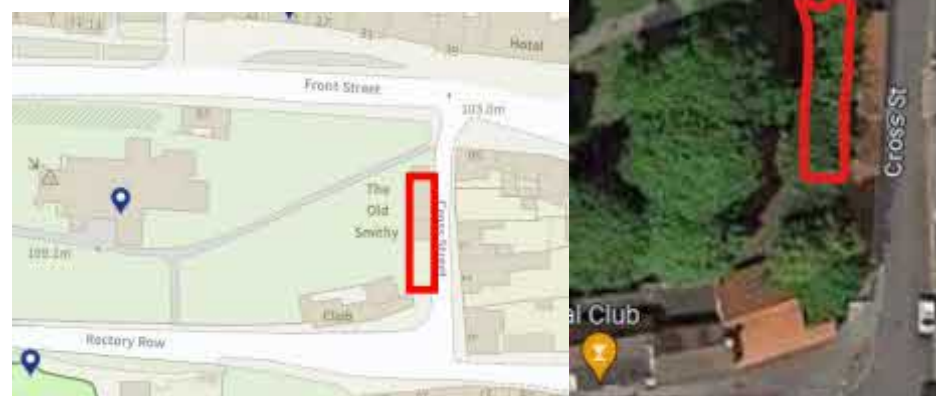
We are trying to cut back some trees as a matter of urgency as we have discovered on several sections of our roof the trees are causing damage, especially in the strong winds by hitting the top of the roof. We have also found branches are growing under the roof tiles.

We have had a number of leaks due to this issue and had to replace a number of tiles due to broken tiles.

This matter has been agreed with the Church and they are happy for us to carry out this work.

Our aim would be to carry out this work in February to avoid bird nesting season

To maintain the aesthetic as much as possible we are only looking to cut above our property any part which has the potential to cause issues and cutting anything back that is causing issues or has the potential to cause issues with the building (outlined in the plans below)
