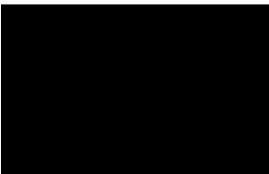
I've looked at a Walnut today at;
The Old Mance
[13 Pelham road](#)
Clavering

We did a reduction on it about 5 + years ago under a TPO and there has been very little regrowth since, either we cut very well to growth points and zero stress growth occurred or it is in slow decline..
There does seem to decline in the upper canopy..

It had multiple decay pockets in major limbs growing towards house and the owner is concerned about the risk to their property please see attached images..

As its a Walnut and they don't react well to hard pruning the consensus between me and the client would be to fell the tree and replant with an alternative species.
There is delamination of the bark on one of the large limbs towards the house that wasn't there when we last worked on the tree and woodpecker holes under the unions.
The tree can't really be seen from the road that much and isn't a high amenity tree from the village POV.
