Horseshoe House - Warfield



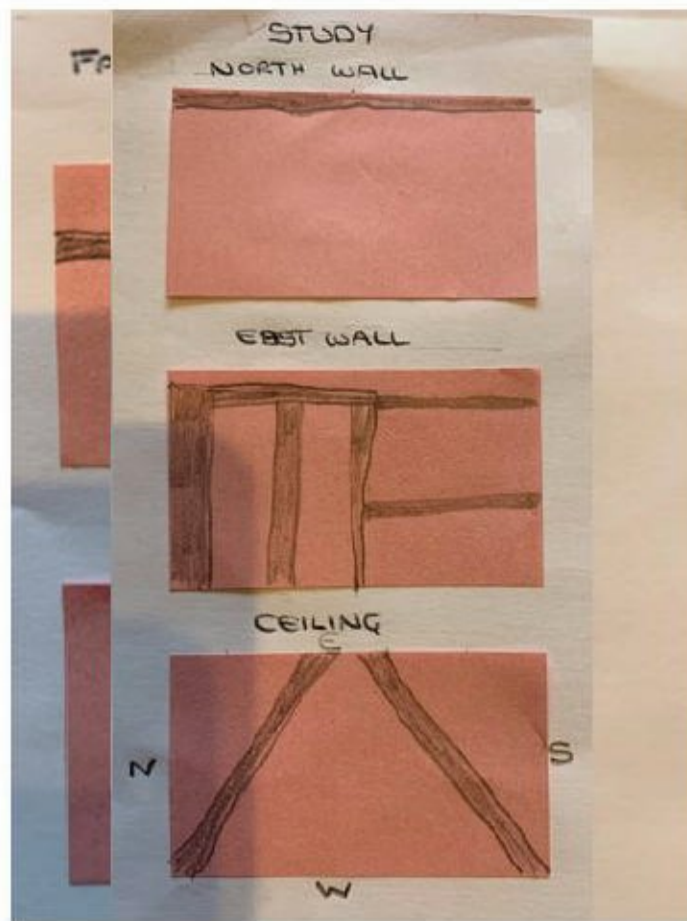
Grade II listed building.
Listed number 1390415.

Assessment of Heritage Significance

Formerly known as: The Four Horse Shoes Public House.
Originally built as a Hall House in early C16, altered late C18 and extended late C20.
MATERIALS: timber frame, part painted render, part brick. Old tile gabled roof with visible rafter ends.
PLAN: formerly rectangular plan of 3 framed bays, now extensions on north, west and south, form T-plan. Farmer Hall in the centre bay.

Not sure why this would be but maybe try resaving and resending it to me again.

Also the beam plans seem to be overlaid so I have therefore separated them – I hope that is ok with you – see attached. Let me know if this is not correct.



I will be honest and say that I cannot confirm if we have everything that we wish to see at this stage even once I have received your heritage statement. I am going to have to ask the Planning Team Manager if we have everything we need to be able to validate the application. If we don't have everything the Heritage Officer is not going to be able to advise us correctly.

Of course I will let you know the current position once I have been able to open the aforementioned document.
