| Tree B - Believed to be a Leylandii - full removal. We have lived at the property for 9 years and this tree was there when we moved in, it is continuing to grow rapidly and again is in close proximity to the boundary garden walls. Under that tree drainage pipes for the rainwater from both properties also runs. There is already evidence of root damage to the walls and pavements as shown on the attached pictures. I would like to remove this tree as I am concerned about the damage to the walls, drainage and pavement as it continues to grow and also feel it does not add to the character of the houses or street and will continue to grow rapidly over the coming years and detract from the street in terms of the conservation area. |
