Description of Proposed Works
Please describe the proposed works
Add two Air Source Heat Pumps (ASHPs)on the flat roof at the back of the Station House. The flat roof is part of an extension built in 1992 with planning permission and LBC on the foundations and to the outline of a part of the building that was demolished in the 1970s.
The flat roof is surrounded by a low parapet wall. Photos of the original structure as it was in the 1960s have recently come to light showing that the parapet wall was originally a little taller.
As part of this proposal, we intend to carefully remove the original coping stones on the parapet, add two courses of brick, and replace the coping stones. This will make the ASHPc even less conspicuous.
The pipework will enter the house and go up to the existing boiler room through the end wall of the kitchen and through the kitchen loft space. As the kitchen was extended in 1991, any apertures for the pipework will go through modern walls, and not involve any change to the historic fabric of the building.

The interior work will include removal of the modern gas boiler and the modern hot water tank. New plumbing will be installed in the boiler room/airing cupboard with a new hot water tanks and the associated pumps etc for the ASHP installation. Pipes will run through an existing hole between the boiler room and the kitchen loft, and out through the end of the kitchen. Some pipes will reuse an aperture and pipe run formerly used for a solar thermal installation on the garage roof that was replaced by a PV system around 15 years ago.
The exterior works will include a boxed-in pipe run from the end of the kitchen wall, down to ground level, under the Waiting Room window, in through the (modern) breeze-block wall of the coal house, and through the parapet onto the flat roof.
Structures fitted to the listed building will be the two ASHPs on the flat roof at the back (furthest from the parapet) sited so that they are almost invisible from the street. However they will be visible from the ramp that goes up to the signal box (run by the charity Lowdham Railway Heritage).
