I include in this email a copy of an appropriate site plan as requested.

Outlined in blue is the extent of the land that I own. Within that (Outlined in red) is the site of the domestic curtilage of the caravan for which the certificate of lawfulness is sought. And blocked in black is the position of the caravan. I apologise if this was unclear on my site boundary and location plan.

The caravan has been moved around on the land owned by myself over the years. Usually when it due for replacement as you will appreciate. Sometimes there has been two caravans on site while the previous one is being dismantled or removed but only one has been lived in at any one time.
