Good afternoon,

Thank you for your assistance, attaching the required form and extra pictures of the walnut tree.

The Walnut tree is approximately 6 - 7 meters in height, 3 meters to the first fork in the trunk with 3 - 4 meters hanging over the oil tank. In order to reduce the weight we would suggest that 2 - 2.5 meters (most of the overhanging branches) be removed.

It looks like similar work was done in the past.

**Proposal:** No 1 - Walnut tree dangerously leaning towards the oil tank, bearing in mine the increasing strong winds we are seeking permission to reduce the weight by removing the overhanging branches. The trunk of the Walnut tree is 325cm from the oil tank and is 30cm from the log store / tree house. No 2 - Old apple tree 100cm from the cottage, bearing in mind the the higher temperatures and the risk of subsidence we are seeking permission to remove the apple tree. The trunk of the Apple tree is 340cm from the boundary fence and 470cm form the house next door, "Calagone"

This is to remind you that we are awaiting a response to our letter sent to you on 29/01/2024. At present we are still unable to register the above application for the following reasons:

• The tree location plan is illegible, a separate email has been sent with a plan attached for you to annotate and return.
