Proposal: T1: Ash - Pollard canopy by approx 2m. Reason for works, the canopy has a heavy lean to the left and nothing on the right hand side. Looking to pollard to reset the shape of the whole canopy.
T2: Birch - Reduce height of the canopy by approx 2.5m
T3: Maple - Thin 10%
T4: Birch - Reduce height of canopy by approx 3.5m and remove two lateral branches on left hand side that interfere with the Maple's canopy
