

## Tree Management – 14 Marine Terrace, Muchalls

14 Marine Terrace is within the Muchalls Conservation Area.

A survey was carried out on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2024, and tree works are required for health and safety as shown in the following table.

## Tree Management

---

| No | Species      | Description/Action   | Replanting                               |
|----|--------------|--|--|
| 1  | Sycamore     | Multi-stemmed tree from 3 – 4m.<br>Pollard tree and leave as wildlife monolith.  |  |
| 2  | Elm          | Tree leaning over adjacent tree and south garden wall. Tree has slightly uprooted and main stem has cracked. Reduce tree and remove branches of neighbouring tree. |  |
| 3  | Norway maple | Four-stemmed from 3.5m. Reduce canopy and allow to grow a secondary crown.   |  |
| 4  | Sycamore     | Tall, thin tree. Fell.   | 5 No beech<br>( <i>Fagus sylvatica</i> ) |
| 5  | Elm          | Large tree with two main stems dividing into a multi-stemmed tree. Tree dying – nearly dead. Fell.   |  |
